MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING between Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV), Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) and University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi for 2020-21

This is a tri-Partite Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) being signed among Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), University Grants Commission (UGC)

and

the third party, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh (hereafter referred to as Central University)

With the objective to assess and facilitate the performance of the University on selected key parameters against the targets set so as to incrementally improve the performance of the University.

PART 1 VISION, MISSION AND OBJECTIVES

1.1 Vision

To develop enlightened citizenship of a knowledge society for peace and prosperity of individuals, nation and the world, through promotion of innovation, creative endeavours, and scholarly inquiry and to be a global destination of higher education and research.

1.2 Mission

To serve as a beacon of change, through multi-disciplinary learning, for creation of knowledge community, by building a strong character and nurturing a value-based transparent work ethics, promoting creative and critical thinking for holistic development and self-sustenance for the people of India. The University seeks to achieve this objective by cultivating an environment of excellence in teaching, research and innovation in pure and applied areas of learning.


1.3 Objectives

- 1.3.1 To disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit;
- 1.3.2 To make special provisions for integrated courses in humanities, social sciences, science and technology in its educational programmes;
- 1.3.3 To take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching-learning process and inter-disciplinary studies and research;
- 1.3.4 To educate and train manpower for the development of the country;
- 1.3.5 To establish linkages with industries for the promotion of science and technology;
- 1.3.6 To pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people, their intellectual, academic and cultural development.

PART 2 **EXERCISE OF ENHANCED AUTONOMY AND DELEGATION OF FINANCIAL POWERS**

- 2.1 All such powers are available to the Executive Council (EC) of the Vishwavidyalaya as are provided for by the Act and Statutes as well as Ordinances framed there under. The Executive Council (EC) shall not use its power to lay down any policy that has an overriding or overruling impact on the University's Act.
- 2.2 The Vishwavidyalaya shall endeavour to ensure gradual annual increase in the user charges / fees charged by it for its various courses and facilities.
- 2.3 The Vishwavidyalaya shall strictly follow the General Financial Rules, 2017 issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, and Government of India in all its financial transactions including procurement of goods and services.
- 2.4 The Vishwavidyalaya shall adopt the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) for receipt of all funds from UGC / Government of India and make all payments through the PFMS till the last mile as far as possible.
- 2.5 The Vishwavidyalaya shall send to the MHRD and UGC any information required by it to satisfy any requirement related to Parliamentary Matters, RTI, Court Cases, Public Grievances or inputs to policy decision to be taken by the UGC/MHRD within reasonable time specified by the UGC/MHRD.
- 2.6 In addition to the above, such decision which creates financial liabilities on UGC/ MHRD shall be taken up by the Vishwavidyalaya with the prior approval of UGC / MHRD.
- 2.7. In fulfilment of its obligations under the MoU, the Vishwavidyalaya shall undertake to achieve certain level of performance for the year 2020-21. The performance will be assessed based on the information provided by the Vishwavidyalaya as per the criteria listed in the **Annexure** enclosed.

PART 3 **FACILITATION /ASSISTANCE FROM THE GOVERNMENT/UGC**

- 3.1. The Vishwavidyalaya has made the commitment of Performance Evaluation Targets based on certain assumptions in respect of release of grants from Government/UGC and raising from other resources, including loan from HEFA for expansion of infrastructural facilities, which has a direct bearing on the performance of the Vishwavidyalaya committed in this MoU.
 - 3.2. UGC/MHRD will extend any other facilitation/assistance like taking up the matters with the State Government concerned or any Ministry/Department of the Union Government, as and when required.

PART 4 ACTION PLAN FOR IMPLEMENTATION AND MONITORING OF THE MoU

- 4.1 Performance evaluation against these MoU parameters shall be carried out every six months and monitored by the Vishwavidyalaya.
- 4.2 The performance evaluation so carried out shall be submitted to the Executive Council (EC) of the Vishwavidyalaya during the EC meetings for consideration. After the EC meeting, the same shall be sent to UGC along with its recommendations.
- 4.3 A joint review by the Vishwavidyalaya, UGC and MHRD shall be carried out within 180 days of completion of the financial year. The result of the joint review shall be placed before the EC and hosted prominently on the website of the Vishwavidyalaya.

PART 5 REQUIREMENT FROM THE UGC AND MHRD


The Vishwavidyalaya shall submit detailed proposal alongwith detailed justifications to UGC/MHRD, duly approved and recommended by its Finance Committee/Executive Council. UGC/ MHRD may liberally consider release of funds as per given justifications. Besides, UGC/MHRD will also provide administrative support and permissions wherever required as per the provisions of the Central Universities Act, 2009.

The Objectives of the MOU are:

- a) To promote effective application of resources.
- b) To promote the Incubation, Internship, Mentorship and Research.
- c) To organize Training and Workshops for Incubatees and Students.
- d) To cooperate in Educational areas of mutual interest.

1. Technical Areas of Collaboration

- a) To facilitate delivering Expert Lectures to Incubatees and Students.
- b) To provide a platform to share and exchange of Best Practices.
- c) To facilitate the Training and Career Enhancement Program.
- d) To facilitate the exchange program of Staff, Students and Interns.
- e) To establish channels of communication and co-operation.
- f) To enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU.

2. Proposed Modes of Collaboration

B.INCUBE and GGV propose to collaborate through the following:

- a) Cooperation and promotion of education, training, mentorship, research in area of mutual interest.

3. Terms and Conditions

- a) Nothing contained in this agreement is intended, nor shall it be constructed as creating a partnership or joint venture between the parties, nor as creating or requiring any ongoing or continuing relationship or commitment between both the parties, beyond the relationship specially created by this MoU. Unless specifically provided otherwise herein, No party, or representative shall be deemed to be a representative, agent or employee of any other party by contract, by employment or for any purpose whatsoever.
- b) B.INCUBE and GGV shall hold appropriate meetings on problems and resolve them by mutual interest.
- c) That the GGV will extend the necessary support to B.INCUBE by allowing its faculty to be a mentor to the incubatees of the B.INCUBE on the technology trends and in house requirements. The institute shall for the same purpose provide a list of faculty interested in the mentorship program of B.INCUBE.

- d) That the B.INCUBE incubatees will have access to the laboratory, auditorium, and other various infrastructural facilities of the institution as per the requirement/use time to time with the permission of Institute.
- e) That the B.INCUBE shall provide Training, Development and Internship program for students and faculties of the institute.
- f) That the B.INCUBE shall provide Mentors, Speakers, and Entrepreneurs to the institute for conducting events, workshops and mentoring sessions.
- g) That the B.INCUBE shall provide incubation to selected promising start-ups of start-up cell/ Alumni of the institute.
- h) That the B.INCUBE shall provide access to its program partners to the institute and vice-versa.
- i) That the B.INCUBE shall ensure industry interaction for student entrepreneurs.
- j) The institute will provide infrastructure for conducting events, workshops, and mentoring sessions.
- k) The institute will bear the total cost of any event organised at GGV with the help of B.INCUBE.
- l) That neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party.
- m) Either party may use the logo of one another to convey association on the websites of both the parties and shall mutually promote events of one another on their social media pages, websites etc.
- n) Both agree to help, identify and invite the faculty members and researchers from other institutes to participate in Conferences, Workshops and Short term courses.
- o) This MoU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the Parties at any time.
- p) Either Parties shall have the right to terminate this MoU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other parties.
- q) That any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by mutual consent and if not resolved, then provision of Chhattisgarh Madhyastham Adhikaran Adhinyam, 1983 shall apply.
