 - ❖ Students to choose one out of the two courses.
 - ❖ As per UGC CBCS guidelines, University / Departments have liberty to offer GE and SEC courses offered by any department to students of other departments. The No. of GE course is four. One GE course is compulsory in first 4 semesters each in undergraduation. In present scheme it is proposed to have minimum two GE courses (from one subject) in first two semester after which student shall change two GE for another subject in 3rd and 4th semester, so that all students can have exposure of one additional subject.

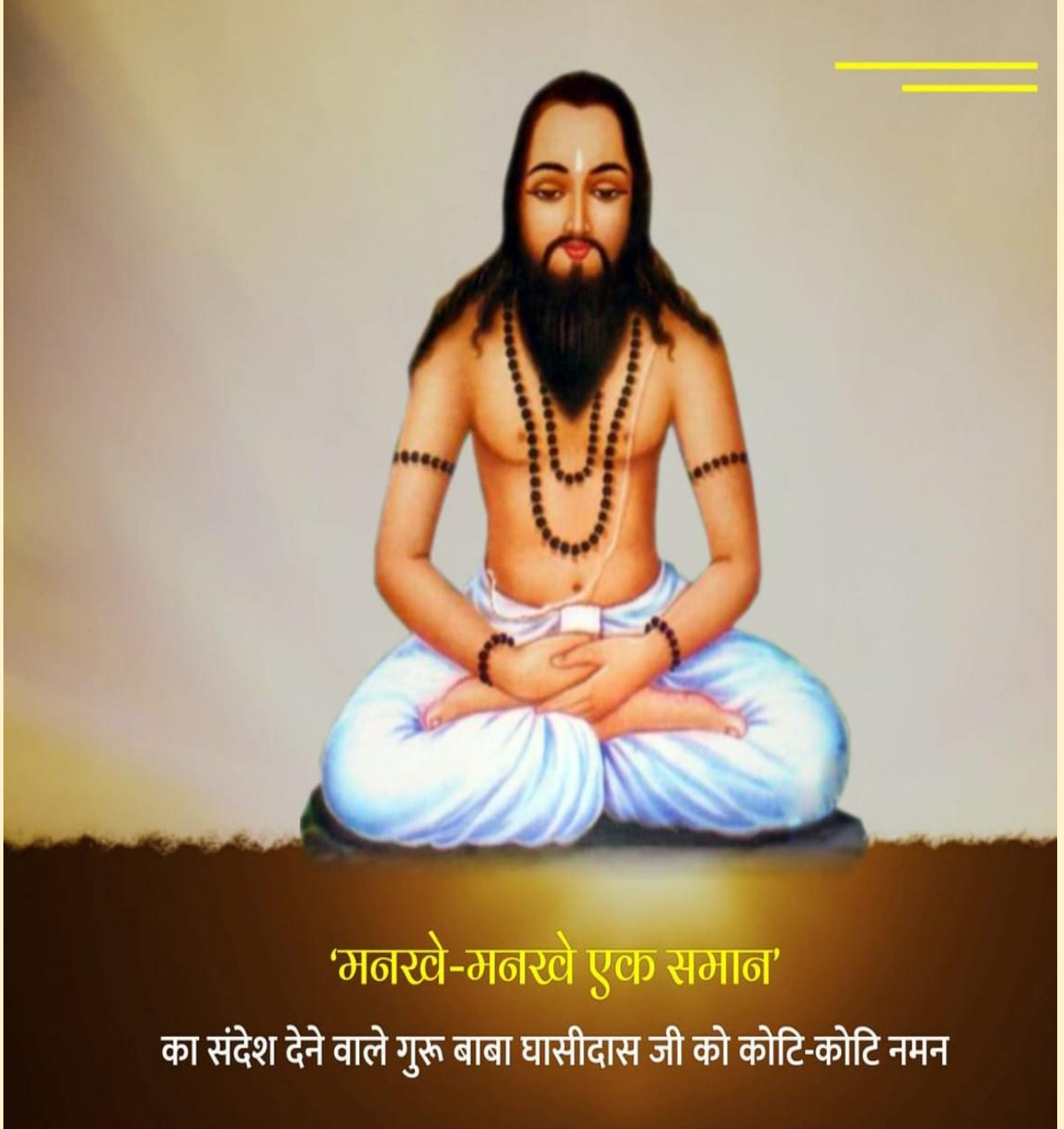
