

Plantation Drive (22/06/2022)

On June 22, 2022, the Forestry Department planted 250 trees on the Guru Ghasidas University campus under the supervision and direction of the Honourable Vice Chancellor, Alok Kumar Chakrawal. Many different mango varieties, such as Amrapali, Dussehri, Langra, and Malika and Jamun trees, have been planted in the plantation.

The honourable vice chancellor requested that as many trees as possible be planted, thus that is what is being done. On this occasion, he stated, "We have to rank our university campus better than what we have in the International Green Matrix Ranking." According to the International Green Matric 2021, the University was ranked 672 and 28 position in the Country.

Each student and scholar in the department should be given a tree to care for for four years as part of the efforts of the Guru Ghasidas University Forestry Department in order to increase the success rate of freshly planted trees. All of the department's faculty members and students took part in the planting programme, including Professor SS Singh, the dean, Dr. K.K. Chandra, the head, and a significant number of other teaching and non-teaching staff members and students.

During this rainy season, the Vice-Chancellor will supervise the planting of 10,000 various types of trees on the university campus. Both university students and researchers will gain from this because it will boost biodiversity within the facility and provide a variety of genetically different trees available for research initiatives. It will aid research on various subjects, including biodiversity.
