WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY REPORT

Date: 05 June 2023

The World Environment Day was celebrated by the department of Forestry, Wildlife & Environmental Sciences, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur, C. G.

In compliance of the guidelines and direction from Ministry of education Government of India, this year the occasion was celebrated for a months started from 6 May 2023, where theme based activities were organized in the university. The theme of the celebration was on Mission Life where six theme were chosen including avoid food wastage, composting of organic and decomposable waste, use of less paper, plastic free campus and use of EV for transports. A national workshop on Mission life organized on 4th June 2023 where Dr. Ram Bhuj, CEO Mobius Foundation Delhi, India, Former Member of UNESCO & SACAM were the speaker. On the monthly celebration various competitions viz. painting, poster writing, cycle rally, campaign on plantation, plastic free campus etc were organized. • <u>Avoid food wastage in Hostels and Cafeterias – promote serving of small portions </u>•

Date: 11.05.2023

To create awareness among the masses, the students of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya campaigned a rally regarding 'Avoid of Food Wastage in Hostels and Cafeterias'. From small canteens within the campus to large dining halls of hostels, the amount of food wastage is a matter of concern. Raising awareness about the serious problems prevailing in the world like hunger and malnutrition, the students urged not to waste the food. Thus, to make people sensitive towards this important issue and for environmental consciousness, the students appealed for adapting the ways to cut down meal wastage within the premises.





• <u>Setting up composting centres for making compost out of dried</u> leaves/waste food/ organic waste to be utilised as manures •

Date: 09.05.2023

To implement the concept of sustainable environment and green campus, the students of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya carried out the litter collection activity in the campus. Various organic waste like dry leaves, twigs, plant stalks, etc. were collected for the preparation of the compost. The collected litter was dumped in several compost pit set up at different parts of the university. The basic purpose of this activity was to promote clean and green campus and to reduce the consumption and dependency upon chemical fertilizers by preparing organic manure through collected litter.







• Creating less paper or Digital Campuses to avoid use of paper •

Date: 12.05.2023

With the motive of saving nature, conserving environment and trees, the students of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya gave the message of less use of paper and digital campus. Students informed that the environmental effects of paper production include deforestation, the use of enormous amount of energy and water as well as air pollution and waste problems. Through an awareness rally, the students plead for the reduction in the consumption of the paper in the University. The students emphasized the digitalization of the campus to cut down the use of paper for environmental sustainability.
