



Advertisement for JRF/JPF Position

Applications are invited for the position of JRF/JPF (01) to work under the Ministry of Environment & Forest (MoEF), Government of India sponsored project entitled "Application of RS & GIS for integrated management of Hasdeo River Watershed (A Tributary of Mahanadi river) of Chhattisgarh" upto 31 March 2016. The posts are temporary and co-terminus with the project.

The minimum qualifications are as under:

- (1) JRF [Rs. 16000/- per month + HRA]: M.Sc. in Forestry/Forestry, Wildlife & Environmental Sciences/Environmental Science/Remote Sensing/ Botany/M. Tech. Remote Sensing with 55% marks and NET/GATE qualified.

(If NET qualified candidates will not available then non NET candidates will be considered and they will be treated as Junior Project Fellow (JPF) with [Rs. 10,000/- per month + HRA]

The upper age limit for JRF - 28 years as on 01/04 2015.

A relaxation up to 5 years will be given to SC/ST/Women/PH/OBC candidates for the position of JRF/JPF.
