Application are invited from the highly motivated candidates for Junior Research Fellow (JRF) position in Science and Engineering Research Board (SERB)-DST, sponsored project, under Start-Up Research Grant (Young Scientist), entitled “**Molecular evaluation of glutamate-NO-cGMP cascades modulated by NMDA and AMPA receptors in brain of rates with acute liver failure**” under the principal investigator **Dr. SANTOSH SINGH**. The details and minimum qualifications are as follows:

Essential qualification: M.Sc. in Zoology/Biochemistry/Biotechnology/Life Sciences subjects with at least 55% of marks. NET/GATE qualified candidates will be given preference. Upper age limit is 28 years. 5 years age relaxation is admissible for female/SC/ST and PH candidates. All qualification being equal, SC/ST candidates will be given preference as per GOI rules.

Duration of the project and fellowship: Three Years (Co-terminus with the project); as per the SERB (DST) norms.

Desirable: Candidates with the experience in Biochemistry and molecular biology field would be preferred.
