
Pre -Ph.D. Syllabus in Anthropology
With University Regulation
Dept of Anthropology and Tribal Development
GGU, Koni

The syllabus of Pre- Ph.D. course work in Anthropology, Dept of Anthropology and Tribal Development Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya shall consists of three theoretical papers and one seminar presentation. The first two papers shall be compulsory while the third paper shall be an optional paper. The optional papers shall have two alternatives: 1. Theoretical Perspectives in Socio-cultural and Development Anthropology and 2. Applied Biological Anthropology and Human Genetics. The students are to choose any one of the optional papers out of two. The duration of the course will be of six months. There shall be no internal assessment. The examination will be conducted at the end of semester and evaluation after completion of six months course work with minimum of 75 % attendance (Compulsory). The minimum passing marks for individual paper is 40 % and however, in an aggregate it should not be less than 60 % (As per university Ph.D. regulation). The seminar will be mandatory but qualifying on recommendation of DRC and the approval of chairmen of DRC per rule of university issued from time to time. The evaluation process of seminar will be as follows”-
