
The following resolutions are taken after deliberation and discussion:


1. The syllabi of U.G. in Anthropology (BA/Bsc) (2011-12), (2012-13), (2013-14) were considered thoroughly by the Board and the app Board made necessary revision in the syllabi of 2011-12 i.e. for 6th Semester, 2012-13 for 4th Semester onwards, 2013-14 for 2nd Semester onwards keeping in view modern trends in anthropology and employment prospect of students. The syllabus of 2014-15 is made completely new which will come in to effect from July 2014. The course structure is at par with course structure of Life Sciences for 2013-14 & 2014-15.
2. The Course Curriculum of P.G. (MA./Msc) in Anthropology was thoroughly reviewed by the Board and the Board made necessary modification as per suggestions of Expert member & other members. The syllabus of P.G. (MA./Msc) in Anthropology was revised with effect from Second Semester onwards incorporating modern trends in Anthropology. The syllabus of MA/Msc in Anthropology for 2014-15 is made completely new & keeping in view UGC model syllabus & syllabi of other universities. The course structure is at par with structure of Life Sciences.
3. Resolved that UG (BA/Bsc) in Anthropology for 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 (Part revision) & 2014-15 (new) be approved. The

4. Resolved that the syllabi of PG (MA/Msc) in Anthropology for 2013-14 (<sup>partial</sup> ~~partial~~) & 2014-15 (Nov) be approved.
5. Resolved that the University authorities may be requested to provide financial grants <sup>to the Dept</sup> for purchase of equipment (for Molecular Anthropology Lab) and for purchase of other Labs <sup>requirements</sup> of the Dept in view of the need of practical needs of the syllabus / Course Content structure of MA/Msc in Anthropology as per the UGC Unified Syllabus.
6. Resolved that the University authorities may kindly consider the acute shortage of space ~~for conducting academic activities~~ <sup>that the department is facing</sup> in ~~the Dept and may~~ <sup>degree</sup> in pursuing academic activities of the Dept.
7. Resolved that students with B.A. <sup>degree</sup> completing their Master's degree in Anthropology may be awarded M.A. in Anthropology, whereas students with B.Sc. <sup>degree</sup> completing their Master's degree in Anthropology may be awarded M.Sc. in Anthropology.
