MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

GURU GHASIDAS VISHWAVIDYALAYA, BILASPUR CHHATTISGARH

AND

CENTRE FOR STUDIES ON HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT, RAIPUR CHHATTISGARH

1. This Memorandum of Understanding is made on the 11.04.2022 between the Centre for Studies on Holistic Development, Raipur, Chhattisgarh hereinafter referred to as CSHD which unless repugnant to the context would include their successors, assigners, agents and executor on one part and Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, herein after referred to as GGV which unless repugnant to the context would include their successors, assigners, agents and executor on the other part.
2. CSHD came into existence in 2018 through Chhattisgarh Society Registration Act 1973. The jurisdiction of CSHD extends to the State of Chhattisgarh. CSHD is working for the students, youths, women, caste and tribal people of the State of Chhattisgarh in particular and India in general with respect to solve various problems each sections of the society encountered in their day to day life. The organisation basically works in collaborations with government departments, autonomous bodies like State and Central Universities and like minded national and international agencies. The financial support for implementing various development programmes is generated from donations, charity support, national and international collaborations.

3. GGV is a Central University located in Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh, India. Established under Central Universities Act 2009, No-25 of 2009. Formerly known as Guru Ghasidas University, established by an Act of the State Legislative Assembly, was formerly inaugurated on June 16, 1983. It is named after Guru Ghasidas, the founder of the Satnami movement in the region. The jurisdiction of the university is spread across the Bilaspur Revenue Division. It covers almost entire spectrum of the higher education requirements of the local/regional/national population. It has several university teaching Departments in its campus.

4. INTENT OF WORK:

Through this Memorandum of Understanding, based on the principles of equality, reciprocity and mutual benefits, CSHD, Raipur Chhattisgarh and GGV, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh here by agree to explore the following avenues of research, development and extension support exchange:

1. To undertake research on various issues confronted by the tribal people, women, youths, adolescents, children of Chhattisgarh in particular and India in general.
2. To collaborate in taking Research Projects and impact assessments relating to the development of tribal communities of Chhattisgarh and India.
3. To exchange skills by way of pooling human resources for the development of the students and tribal people both at CSHD and GGV.
4. To promote Mentorship of students' projects by the resources groups of both the organisations.
5. To formulate tribal centric development models, publish reports and monographs and to organise seminars, conferences, special lectures, public debates on various themes relating to the tribal people of India focussing the development needs of Chhattisgarh and Central India.
6. To monitor socio-economic and political developments that have a bearing on India's unity and integrity, analyse the causes of ethnic conflicts leading to extremisms.
7. To organise self employment and skill development camps to generate gainful employment potential for tribal people and students.
8. To advice State and national governments pertaining to the tribal development plans, policies and programmes in India in collaboration with specialised world bodies

The collaboration between GGV and CSHD will continue initially for a period of three years, when both CSHD and GGV will enlarge their networks to contribute for the promotion of above objectives and engage themselves in a meaningful dialogue on the kind of works both wants to promote.

Prior to the implementation of any of the above mentioned-items, details shall be negotiated and agreed upon by both the universities.

BENEFITS TO CSHD FROM THIS COLLABORATION:

- I. **CSHD** will be benefitted by providing opportunities to the tribal people by mobilising the intellectual and infrastructural resources of GGV.
- II. **CSHD** will get a platform to excel its resources, development, extension activities and advocacy programmes for the students, tribal people and to the government of Chhattisgarh and India.
- III. Tribal people of the region and particularly of the Central India will be benefitted and the role of **CSHD** in this respect will be more visible and strengthened.
- IV. **CSHD** will establish policy dialogues with different national and international agencies pertaining to various development issues of both tribal and minorities of Chhattisgarh and India with the academic and intellectual support of the rich faculties of GGV.
- V. **CSHD** will organise seminar, conference, and intellectual meets for students, researchers and development workers by using the intellectual resources of GGV.

BENEFITS TO GGV FROM THIS COLLABORATION:

- I. **GGV** will be benefitted by providing opportunities to the students and Ph.D scholars by mobilising the empiric study and advocacy based intellectual resources of **CSHD**.
- II. **GGV** will get a platform to excel its academic resources and programmes for the students, researchers of different teaching departments particularly of Social Sciences and Arts.
- III. **GGV** will be benefitted by providing opportunities to the students for summer and winter intern programs which will help the field exposure and skills development of the students.
- IV. Tribal students of the university representing different regions and of central India will be benefitted and the role of **GGV** in this respect will be more visible.

ARBITRATION:

Except in noting the existence of this Educational, Research, Development and Extension Partnership Agreement, no use of the name, symbols, signs or trademarks of one institution shall be used by the other.

This agreement shall become effective on the date of its signing and continue thereafter for **three** years subject to revision or modification by mutual agreement and unless terminated by either of the two parties hereto. Termination by one institution shall be effected by giving the other institution at least ninety (90) days' advance written notice of its termination. In such circumstances, any




