

Admission Procedure/General Instructions

1. Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur invites online applications for admission to the various programmes for the academic session 2023-24 through **Common University Entrance Test CUET (UG) 2023 to be conducted by NTA.**
2. **For Foreign Nationals policy of admission is attached separately.**
3. **Guidelines for submission of online application form as notified by NTA** are available separately on <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/>. It is suggested to the applicants that before submitting online application forms read the instructions carefully. Mere appearance in the CUET UG 2023 or inclusion of name in the merit list does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to a course unless he/she fulfils the prescribed eligibility conditions for that programme.
4. Age should not be more than **22 years** for Under Graduate Programmes **and 25 years** for Post Graduate Programmes, B.P.Ed, B.Lib. & Inf.Sc. and Diploma Programmes **as on 1-July-2023.** For M.Pharm and M.Lib. & Inf.Sc. Programmes, the upper age limit is 27 years. For M.P.Ed. Programme, the upper age limit is 28 years. There will be no upper age limit for **B.Ed. & M.Ed./BA-LLB/B. Com LLB** Programmes.
5. **Date of Entrance Test, Test method, Application fee, Entrance Test centre, Syllabus for Entrance Test, Admission procedure etc. will be notified by National Testing Agency (NTA) from time to time and the same may be uploaded on the University website www.ggu.ac.in. Therefore, it is suggested to all applicants that they have to visit NTA website, CUET 2023 links and www.ggu.ac.in regularly.**

ADMISSION DETAILS:

(i) RELAXATION IN MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR SC, ST & PWD CATEGORIES:

All SC, ST & PWD candidates who have passed the qualifying examination are eligible to appear in the entrance examination irrespective of their percentage of marks.

(ii) RELAXATION IN UPPER AGE LIMIT FOR SC, ST, OBC & PWD CATEGORIES:

There is age relaxation of 5 years for SC, ST & PWD candidates and 3 years for OBC candidates for admissions in various courses in upper age limit wherever the upper age limit is prescribed.

(iii) Relaxation for the wards of Kashmiri Migrants in admission based on the instruction of UGC/MoE.

(iv) If the candidates' aggregate percentage of marks in the qualifying examination is below the stipulated minimum percentage of aggregate marks, his/her provisional admission will also stand automatically cancelled and the candidate will not be entitled to claim refund of fees.

6. Fee once paid to the University will not be refunded fully to the applicant. It will be refunded to the candidates only after necessary deductions as stipulated in GGV Ordinances.
7. **Nomenclature and duration of the UG programmes may be modified by the University in accordance with NEP 2020.**
8. Jurisdiction: All disputes related to admission in Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya particularly will be subject to Bilaspur jurisdiction only.
