
I. PURPOSE & SCOPE


The purpose of this MOU is to clearly identify the roles and responsibilities of each party as they relate to collaborate for an internship program.


In particular, this MOU is intended to:

- 4) Certificate: The intern has to be provided with certificates signed by competent authority in the certificate for encouraging the interns participating in the program.


IV. CHHATRA KALYAN NYAS RESPONSIBILITIES UNDER THIS MOU

VII. EFFECTIVE DATE AND SIGNATURE







I. ABOUT THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- i. This Educational Cooperation MOU defines the principles, policy guidelines & procedures which EDII and GGV wish to develop on the basis of mutual interest. This co-operation includes entrepreneurship education, start-up and incubation support, exchange of students, faculty development, promotion of entrepreneurship (grassroots, indigenous, family business) in nearby university areas, conduction of workshops and exhibitions, exchange of information and academic publications.
- ii. This MOU shall be reviewed after three years and changes specifying the method of co-operation and modalities between the EDII and GGV will be incorporated with mutual consent.

II. PURPOSE

In recognition of both the premier Institutions in their respective fields of education, for the professional growth in the education field and entrepreneurship for the purposes of the exchange for students, staffs and faculty, the Institutions herewith establish, at the institutional level, the principles, policy and procedures which shall be required to facilitate such exchange programs and mechanism between the institutions.

III. OBJECTIVE


The objective of this MOU is to encourage collaboration and exchange between the two institutions at national and international level to benefit from each other's strengths and provide scope for wider learning to the students of both the Institutes to entrepreneurship and design promotion and further as follows:

- i. Sharing of knowledge and resources between the Institutes in the academic interest of students and faculty members
- ii. Promote Entrepreneurship Education at GGV and in the Central Region of Chhattisgarh
- iii. Conduct of Academic Events, Start-up Related Events, Lectures, Workshops and Exhibitions
- iv. Exchange of information, Joint Research and Collaborative Academic Publications

IV. SCOPE

The MOU between GGV, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh and EDII covers the implementation of Entrepreneurship Courses at GGV, Faculty and Student Exchange program between EDII Ahmedabad and GGV, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh as specified in terms of the MOU herein:

V. ACADEMIC COLLABORATION


The MOU between GGV, Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh and EDII covers the areas of collaboration and sharing between both the Institutions, specified as follows:

- a. **Conduct of Entrepreneurship Courses at GGV:** EDII will design the entrepreneurship courses curriculum and support GGV in implementation of Entrepreneurship courses as Minor and/or Electives at both UG and PG level.
- b. **Student Start-up and Incubation:** EDII will support GGV students in creating, launching and sustaining start-ups. Also, EDII will support GGV in implementation of Pre-Incubation, Incubation and Post-Incubation activities at GGV, Bilaspur.
- c. **Faculty Sharing for Academic Programmes:** Both the Institutions may invite the faculty members as visiting /guest faculty to teach specific module / subject on the basis of mutual agreement and the availability of the faculty member. During this period the invited faculty members will be paid the honorarium as per the mutually agreed terms and conditions. Travelling & Living expenses of the faculties will be paid by the host institute in case faculty has to travel from one center to another center.
- d. **Faculty Training:** Need based customized training programme for GGV faculty members can be designed, organized and conducted by EDII.
- e. **Resource Centre Sharing:** Facilities related to Resource Centre / Knowledge Management Centre available in each Institution will be shared without any fee charged by each other but it would follow the inter-institutional library norms.
- f. **Joint Publication:** Faculty and scholars of both the Institutions may work jointly on publications. Faculty and students of each Institution can contribute towards the journals /edited books etc.
- g. **Sharing of Experts / Faculty:** Depending on the availability, suitability and situation emerging in future EDII will share its network of experts and faculty members as and when possible. Expenses for such sharing will be worked out on mutually agreeable terms and on case to case basis. GGV will have to arrange logistics and honorarium for such experts.

VI. DURATION OF THE MOU

- i. This MOU becomes effective upon the signature of the designated officials of both institutions.
- ii. Its actual implementation will begin as soon as both institutions have identified the planned activities.
- iii. This MOU is valid for a period of three years from the date of signature.

VII. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the event of disagreement or disputes of any kind whatsoever between staff and/or officers of either of the parties, the same shall be amicably resolved at Ahmedabad/ Gandhinagar jointly by the Director General of EDII and Vice-Chancellor of GGV whose decision shall be binding on the parties.

VIII. GOVERNING LAW

The governing law of the MOU shall be the Indian Law & the disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at Gujarat.

IX. FORCE MAJEURE


That force majeure clause shall be applicable: Neither party shall be liable to each other for any loss or damage occasioned by arising out of acts of God such as unprecedented floods, volcanic eruptions, earthquake or other convulsion of nature and other acts.

- b. **Intellectual property rights:** Both Parties undertake that they shall not infringe upon any copyright or other intellectual property rights of the other Party which shall remain in exclusive possession of the respective Parties. Both parties shall obtain permission in writing for the usage of any logo, motif, emblem, or any other intellectual property right vested in the respective Parties to be used in connection with the implementation of the present MOU from the respective Party. Each Party is the sole owner of such intellectual property rights and the other Party shall have no rights thereto if not expressly mentioned in this MOU. Neither Party may use the other party's intellectual property rights without the prior consent of that Party. Nothing contained in this MOU is intended to, or shall be construed to grant to either Party any license or right regarding the other Party's Intellectual Property Rights.

- d. **Waiver:** No waiver by either Party of any breach of any condition, covenant or term of this Agreement shall be effective unless it is in writing and no failure or delay by either Party in insisting upon strict performance of any of the terms or conditions of this MOU or in exercising any right, power or privilege here under shall operate as a waiver thereof.
- e. **Assignment and subcontracting:** Neither Party hereto shall assign any of its rights or obligations or sub-contract the same under this MOU to any third party without the prior written consent of the otherparty.
- f. **Entire MOU:** This MOU constitutes the complete expression of both Parties' MOUand understanding with respect to the subject matter herein and supersedes all other prior agreements, undertakings, obligations, promises, arrangements, communications, negotiations and understandings whether oral or written, by the Parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.
- g. **Modification:** This MOU and may be amended or modified only by a mutual consent and written agreement by both Parties. Any such amendment and modifications will be listed in an Annexure hereto.
- h. **Notices:** Any notices required to be sent under this MOU by one Party to the other shall be in writing and forwarded to the other Party to the following addresses:
- i. If statements must be made in writing, they are deemed to having been made in writing when using electronic data communication or any other machine-readable form as long as the originator of the message is identifiable.
- j. **Independent Contractors:** Both parties shall not for any purpose, be deemed or represent itself to be an agent or representative of the other Party. The relationship between the Parties shall only be that of independent contractors.
- k. **Severability:**In the event that any one or more of the provisions contained herein, or the application thereof in any circumstance, is held invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such provision or provisions shall be ineffective only to the extent of such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability, without invalidating the remainder of such provision or provisions or the remaining provisions of this MOU, and such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision or portion thereof shall, to the maximum extent possible, be substituted by an enforceable provision(s) that preserve(s) the original intentions position of the parties.

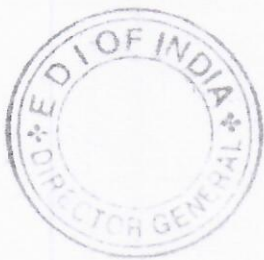

OBJECTIVE OF THE AGREEMENT

1. Purpose

To facilitate optimal utilization of the National Centre for Accelerator Based Research (3 MV High Current Pelletron). facility established at Department of Pure & Applied Physics, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.) 495009 with financial support from the Government of India and University Grants Commission and Department of Atomic Energy as a National Facility by users across the country in partnership with the Inter-University Accelerator Centre, New Delhi under the guidance and oversight of the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi.

182. Name of the Facility

The National Centre for Accelerator Based Research (3 MV High Current Pelletron) facility established at Department of Pure & Applied Physics, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.) 495009 will, upon signing of this MoU, be called "Joint Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya.-IUAC Ion Beam Centre", henceforth called IBC in this document.


253. Management Structure


There shall be a Management Committee for the IBC.

3.1 The composition of the Management Committee shall be as follows:

1. Vice-Chancellor of the University, *ex officio* (co-Chair)
2. Director, IUAC, New Delhi, *ex officio* (co-Chair)
3. Up to 3 Heads of User Departments from the University including the Department of Pure & Applied Physics, where is it established (other two Heads by yearly rotation based on alphabetical names of the User Departments,) (Members)
4. 1 Senior scientist of IUAC (Member)
5. Up to 2 Scientist Nominees of UGC from among the users from institutions other than the University (Members)
6. Official of UGC nominated by UGC (Member)
7. Director/Head/In-charge of the IBC (Member-Secretary)
8. Dean of School of Physical Science (Member)
9. One faculty member from the Department of Pure & Applied Physics (where the facility is established, by rotation annually)

3.2 The Terms of Reference of the Management Committee shall be as follows:

- i. The tenure of the Management Committee will be 5 years, or the term of validity of this MoU, whichever is earlier.
- ii. The Management Committee shall take all necessary decisions – scientific, technical, administrative, financial and of any other relevant kind – regarding the functioning of the IBC so that it is optimally used by users from the University and elsewhere. The decisions of the Management Committee shall be final in respect of the functioning of the IBC. The Management Committee may form necessary guidelines, subject to the stipulations of this MoU, for facilitating different aspects of functioning of the IBC.
- iii. The Management Committee shall meet at least once a year, preferably at a time that would facilitate financial planning for the next year. In addition, meeting/s of the Management Committee may be called with the consent of both the co-chairs at any time.
- iv. Presence of 5 members of the Management Committee shall form a quorum for a meeting.
- v. The Management Committee shall make all possible efforts to reach decisions by consensus. However, if consensus eludes despite best efforts, majority decision shall prevail.

4. Financial Arrangements

- 4.1 There shall be no fund flow from IUAC to the University and *vice versa*.
- 4.2 The Management Committee, at an appropriate time during the year, shall work out the budget for the IBC.
- 4.3 The University shall make funds available for the upkeep of the civil and other physical infrastructure, guest house facilities, etc. and the University staff working at the IBC from its own resources. The University shall follow its own norms and procedures for this.
- 4.4 IUAC, from funds made available by UGC within its budget, shall make funds available for utilities, essential spares and consumables, repair of the machine and repair/replacement of associated essential accessories and reasonable and modest incremental upgrade of the facility. These items will be procured by IUAC and loaned to the University. IUAC shall also bear the manpower cost of its staff posted at the IBC. IUAC will also make funds available for supporting users from other universities/institutions for travel and stay at IBC in case their projects are assigned beam time after peer review.
- 4.5 Various users of the facility, from the University and outside, will be encouraged to bring their own institutional/project funds for carrying out experiments at the IBC.
- 4.6 Any major upgrade of the facility will be treated as a new joint project from the University and IUAC and may be submitted for funding to the UGC. UGC may decide to fund the project, either on its own or in collaboration with other funding agencies like DAE, DST etc.

107 5.2 It will be primarily the responsibility of the University to make the "Core Staff" available for

6.1 IUAC, through its website and also through the websites of the University, shall invite scientific proposals for beam-time allocation in the format designed for beam-time allocation at IUAC accelerators and facilities (60% of the beam time available with IBC).

6.2 The proposals shall be evaluated by the IUAC National Users Committee for beam-time allocation at the IBC. Memberships and Terms of Reference of the IUAC National Users Committee may be suitably amended to allow for consideration of proposals for beam-time allocation at the IBC.

6.3 40% beam time will be allotted by the IBC to the internal users for which proposals will be invited internally. However, these proposals will be evaluated by the IUAC National users committee. The beam time if remains unutilized shall be distributed by the committee to national users.

1617. Academic Programme/s at the IBC

The IBC may design appropriate post-graduate degree programmes and training programmes on accelerators and accelerator-based science and technology around the facilities available at the IBC. The same may be offered after approval by the Management Committee.

1678. Performance Monitoring of the IBC

8.1 The Management Committee shall monitor the performance of the IBC at least once every year and take corrective steps, as necessary, to improve the functioning of the IBC.


8.2 The Management Committee shall evolve quantitative criteria for monitoring the performance of the IBC. Apart from other criteria, it shall include the following parameters: (i) up-time of the machine and associated facilities; (ii) number of users from the University; (iii) number of users from other institutions in the country; (iv) number of papers published in refereed journals; (v) number of PhDs produced based on work done at the IBC; (vi) number of training programmes conducted; (vii) number of technical personnel trained as a result of training programmes; (viii) number of special degree courses run based on the facility; (ix) number of students produced through special degree courses.


8.3 If, at any time, the Management Committee is convinced that the Director/Head/In-Charge of the IBC has not been able to provide effective leadership for efficient functioning of the IBC. The management committee may appoint another person as the Director/Head/In-Charge of the IBC, after approval of executive council of the University and UGC as per the provisions for the appointment of Director/Head/In-Charge of the IBC mentioned in the MoU.

1879. Changes in this MOU

9.1 The terms and conditions of this MoU may be modified and/or changed with the recommendations of the Management Committee and with formal agreement of the three Parties.

9.2 The modifications in the MoU shall come into effect prospectively and shall not invalidate the decisions taken earlier within the provisions of the MOU at that time.



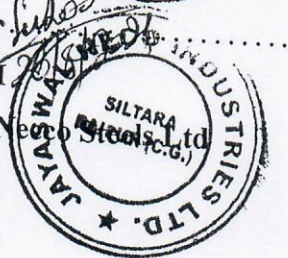

1. Objectives of MoU

3. Details of Programmes/Training/Certification


9. Financial Aspects
