Bhupal Nobles' University hereinafterreferred to as "BNU", Saraswati Marg, Sevashram Chouraha, Airport Road, Udaipur – 313001 constituted under the University Act no 23, 2015 of Rajasthan Vidhan Sabha sponsored by Vidya Pracharini Sabha Estd. 1923 and recognized by UGC. The noble objective of the university is to impart progressive employable education, research, extension, and consultancy through the Multi Faculty system is the First Party.

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (Chhattisgarh) hereinafterreferred to as "GGU", Koni, Bilaspur, (Chhattisgarh), India, 495009, is a Central University established under the Central Universities Act 2009, No. 25 of 2009 to cater to the Academic and Research need of higher education in Central India, is the Second Party.

WHEREAS:

- A. BNU and GGU believe that collaboration and cooperation between both the parties will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- B. The parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts in the area of Education, Research, FacultyTraining,Skill-based training, Extension, Consultancy, etc.
- C. Both parties being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests by collaborating in the field of Education, Research and Extension.

AREAS OF COOPERATION ARE OUTLINED AS UNDER

All over the globe, Universities are experiencing the pressure to combat the challenges of affordability, employability, qualitative and innovative research in academics. Similarly, both the parties intend to work jointly for mutual gains through:

- 1. Joint Research Projects: To undertake joint research projects in the areas of mutual interest and benefits wherever applicable. Both the parties agree to facilitate and coordinate student research work and permit the faculty to be a member/co-advisor of advisory committees for teaching and guiding students of both Universities. The major advisors will be from the respective Universities only. The financial resources if needed will be borne out through specific projects, grants, etc. as decided with mutual consent and no financial obligation will be mandatory on any party.
- 2. Exchange of information: The parties support the widest possible dissemination of information in the areas of qualitative and innovative research and academics. Each party in the joint project shall be given the right to use, disclose, publish or disseminate such information. Rules pertaining to intellectual property rights at both universities will be considered while exchanging any such information.
- 3. Student Exchange: Mutually agrees for collaboration in research, skill-oriented training, placement drives, and wherever applicable. All the expenses will be the direct responsibility of the student concerned.
- 4. Resource Sharing: Both the parties agree to share the common resources such as Instrumentation center, Laboratories, Libraries, IT services, Infrastructural resources, etc. for the researchers and faculties. All the expenses involved will be met by the parties from their own resources.
- 5. Joint Faculty Development Programs: Both parties intend to organize collaborative Faculty Development Programs.
- 6. Joint Skill Development Programs: Both parties intend to organize employable skill development programs with the help of industries for the mutual benefit of students and the community at large.

- 7. Faculty Exchange and Supervising of Students: The faculty members from BNU and GGU will be eligible for the teaching of specific subjects for utilizing the benefits of their expertise in the subjects.
- 8. The faculty members engaged in teaching the specific courses may be eligible for an honorarium for teaching assignments as per the regulations of BNU &GGU.Approved faculties of both universities (BNU & GGU) will be recognized as Co-Guide/Member of Advisory Committee for P.G. &Ph.D. programs as per the need of subject and academic programs.
- 9. **Financial Obligation**:Financial terms and conditions will be decided mutually as per the needs of both parties. This MoU will be considered only for academic and R&D purposes only by both parties.
- 10. Joint Meetings: Both parties agree to organize Joint Conferences, Seminars, Workshops, Conventions, placement drives, and Student cultural Festivals.
- 11. Both parties intend to sign a Joint Memorandum of Agreements with Industry as per requirements of various departments from BNU as well as GGU.
- 12. Both parties agree for Joint publication and dissemination of the outcome of collaborative projects and research. Rules pertaining to intellectual property rights at both universities will be considered while exchanging any such information.

IMPLEMENTATION

The President (Vice-Chancellor) of The BNU and The Vice-Chancellor of The GGU shall be responsible to work out the operational framework and ensure effective implementation of the MoU. The Registrar on behalf of The President of The BNU and The Registrar of GGU on behalf of The Vice-Chancellor of The GGU shall be the Executive Heads for the effective implementation of the MoU. However, the Deans of the respective faculties of both parties shall execute all the mutually agreed operational decisions.

Any intellectual property rights emerging from collaborative projects will be the property of both the Universities (BNU &GGU) in the proportion to the contribution of the investigators. Rules pertaining to intellectual property rights at both universities will be considered while executing any such proceedings.

COMMENCEMENT AND VALIDITY

The MoU shall remain enforced for a period of **Five Years** from the date it is signed by the concerned signatories of the two Universities. It may further be extended or amended with the written agreement of both parties. The MoU may be terminated by either party subject to the delivery of six months' advance notice, in writing. In case both the Universities agree to terminate MoU, the ongoing Research Projects shall be completed as per the already signed MoU and agreed obligations.
