Backdrop of Swachchh Bharat Summer Internship programme:

Guru Ghasidas

Vishwavidyalaya has implemented the Swachh Bharat Summer Internship programme as community related service from session 2017-18. This program in pursuance of the objectives of the Swachh Bharat Mission launched as a national movement on October 2nd, 2014, the Ministry of Human Resource Development, in association with the Swachh Bharat Mission (Garmin), Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation and Ministry of youth affairs is launching a 'Swachh Bharat Summer Internship' programme. Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya has also assigning one Nodal Officer (who is registered on the website) after receiving the letter from MHRD New Delhi on May 9, 2018. Nodal Officer is guiding to students throughout the internship as per the guidelines given by ministries. A website has been developed by the central government for the purpose of registration and reporting throughout the internship period, the link to which is as follows: https://sbsi.mygov.in The internship is open only to the registered students of the Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya and they are expected to take up a project for promotion of cleanliness, by spending an approximate duration of 100 hours the village selected by the student.

As per guideline of the program, all participants will be given a SWACHCHH BHARAT INTERNSHIP CERTIFICATE on completion of the summer internship. Apart from their certificate, the best 3 interns/ teams of interns would be awarded at University level and their names would be forwarded for eligible awards at State and National level.
