# Admission in AICTE Doctoral Fellowship Scheme for Session 2022-23

AICTE, New Delhi has declared School of Studies of Engineering and Technology, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.) as AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) Research Centre. Applications are invited from eligible candidates for admission in Ph.D. under AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) Scheme in the School of Studies of Engineering and Technology, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur. The applications in the prescribed format are invited from the eligible candidates for taking admission in the AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) Scheme in the following branches:

- 1. Civil Engineering
- 2. Chemical Engineering
- 3. Industrial and Production Engineering
- 4. Information Technology
- 5. Mechanical Engineering

#### Details are as follows:

### 1. Admission Criteria & other details:

- 1. ADF Research Center SoS, Engineering and Technology, GGV, Bilaspur.
- 2. No. of seat sanctioned for ADF Scheme for all branches **08** (**Eight**)
- 3. The candidate must have secured the minimum percentage of educational qualification prescribed for eligibility as in Under Graduate and Post Graduate be 70% (69.5 % and above) for General/OBC candidates. In the absence of percentage, the candidate must have secured minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 7.5 on the scale of 10 or equivalent at Bachelors and Masters.
- 4. For SC/ST/Physically Handicapped (PH) candidate, percentage required will be 65% (64.5 % and above). In the absence of percentage, the candidate must have

- secured minimum cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 7.0 on the scale of 10 or equivalent at Bachelors and Masters.
- 5. The students serving as faculty under TEQIP scheme can also be given preference for admission in this programme.
- 6. The minimum percentage criterion for the Indian students' qualified Bachelor/Master's degree from Foreign Universities shall be waived off but student will have to qualify GATE exam during last 5 years.
- 7. In addition to above, the candidate should have qualified GATE/ NET during the last 5 years.
- 8. The candidate should be less than 30 years of age as on date of admission in respective University. However, age relaxation of 5 years would be applicable to candidates belonging to SC/ST/Women/Physically challenged category.
- 9. AICTE supported ADF fellowship is not admissible to left out students, who have already availed the fellowship from AICTE, on his/her taking admission for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in any other Technical University/Institutes.

# 2. <u>Duration of the Scheme/Fellowship:</u>

The duration of the scheme shall be for a period of 3 Years. Normally, no further extension will be granted. In exceptional cases the duration is extendable by 1 year as a special case only on fulfilling the minimum eligibility and on the recommendation of university in the prescribed format duly filled in and signed for consideration of extension of fellowship beyond 3 years as per Annexure-B of guidelines for AICTE doctoral fellowship (ADF) 2022-23.

### 3. Amount of fellowship

The fellowship will be Rs. 31,000/- pm for the first two years followed by Rs. 35,000/- pm for the third year. HRA will be provided at the rate of 8%, 16% and 24% as per the Government of India (GoI) norms as applicable in the city/ location where the Research Fellow is pursuing their research. HRA will not be admissible to those scholars who are availing hostel facility of the University/Institute.

In addition, Contingency Grant will be admissible to the scholars at the rate of Rs.15, 000/-per annum to meet the miscellaneous expenditures.

4. This fellowship scheme is full time research work at the ADF center.

# 5. Selection Criteria:

- 1. As per GGV regulation-2018 for the admission, evaluation and award of degree of Ph.D. under VRET exempted category. Merit for eligible candidates will be prepared considering academic background (10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, UG, PG marks), GATE/NET Score & Personal Interview/ Viva Voce and research proposal presentation as per the provision of GGV Regulation 2018 for admission, evaluation and award of degree of Ph.D.
- 2. Guidelines for AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) 2022-23 available in university website and AICTE website.
- 3. Details are available in the University website www.ggu.ac.in
- 4. Application shall be accepted by speed post/ courier only. Address for sending the application along with attested copies of the required documents is: Dean, School of Studies of Engineering and Technology, GGV, Koni, Bilaspur, C.G., 495009.
- 5. "Application for AICTE Doctoral Fellowship (ADF) 2022-23" should be super-scribed on the envelope.

# 6. Reservation Policy:

The reservation policy of Government of India will be applied as adopted by the GGV, Bilaspur. Applicants applying under reserved categories must produce a valid certificate from competent authority as prescribed by GOI to consider his/her application in that category. In absence of a valid certificate the applicant will be considered in the unreserved category.

# 7. How to Apply:

- 1. Interested eligible candidates should download the application form from www.ggu.ac.in. Along with the filled application form attested copies of the required documents, and proof of the payment of application fee must be submitted. Payment of application fee (non-refundable) can be made through Debit card / Credit card/ Net banking @Rs.1000/- per candidate for UR/EWS/OBC and Rs.500/-for SC, ST and PWD candidates using the online payment link available on the GGV website.

- 3. The candidates are required to verify the intake quota of particular subject (displayed along with admission notification) for Ph.D. programme for ADF, before filling the application form.
- 4. The candidates are requested to read and understand the admission notification/guidelines and the Ph.D. regulations-2018 of GGV & AICTE -ADF guidelines 2022-23 thoroughly.
- 5. The detailed schedule for the entrance test/interview will be displayed on the University website www.ggu.ac.in under "Ph.D. Admissions 2022-23 for ADF" Link. Therefore, the candidates are advised to visit the university website at regular intervals, for all the updates regarding entrance test and admission procedure.
- 6. The merit list of selected candidates and the waiting list (for vacant seats, if any) in order of merit shall be prepared by the concerned DRC. It will be valid for that particular academic year only.

- 2. In case of any dispute/ambiguity/clarification regarding admission in any subject/department, the decision of the Vishwavidyalaya shall be final and binding on applicants.
- 3. Notwithstanding anything contained in the relevant Ordinances, the eligibility requirements for the purpose of admission shall be only those which are mentioned in the Information Bulletin of the academic session concerned.
- 4. All Ph. D. Scholars shall be governed by the Ph. D. Ordinance/Regulations of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya and Award of Fellowship under ADF scheme of AICTE and as amended from time to time.
- 5. No accommodation and Travel allowances will be provided by the University to the candidates called for the interview/admission.
- 6. The candidate should note that their candidature is strictly provisional.
- 7.The applicant must ensure their eligibility for Ph.D. admission 2022-23 under of AICTE-ADF 2022-23 scheme in respect of qualifications and other requisite criteria and then only apply.
