IS PROHIBITED

RAGGING IS AN OFFENCE TOTALLY PROHIBITED IN THE UNIVERSITY AND ANYONE FOUNDUILTY OF RAGGING AND / OR ABETTING RAGGING, WHETHER ACTIVELY OR PASSIVELY, ORBEING A PART OF A CONSPIRACY TO PROMOTE RAGGING IS LIABLE TO BE PUNISHED INACCORDANCE WITH UGC REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHEREDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AS WELL AS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ANY PENAL LAW FORTHE TIME BEING IN FORCE.

What Constitutes Ragging

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:

- Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an actwhich has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any otherstudent;
- ➤ Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activities by any student or students which causes or islikely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear orapprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do andwhich has the effect of causing or generating sense of shame, or torment of embarrassmentso as to adversely affect the physique or psyche or such fresher or any other student;
- Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher;
- > Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to any individual or a group of students;
- Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any otherstudent by students;
- Any act of physical abuse including all variants of its; sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other dangerto health or person.
- Any act or abuse by spoken words, email, post, public insults, which would also includederiving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student;
- Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure of showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Important Points

- Fresher (s) and all other student(s) should desist from doing anything, with or against their will, even if ordered to by the senior students.
- Fresher (s) or any other student (s), whether being victims, or witnesses, in any incident ofragging are advised to promptly report such occurrence at the Anti-Ragging Helpline. Apart from the helpline number the students are free to contact any of the University Officials.
- ➤ The University will ensure that the identity of such informants shall be protected and shall not besubject to any adverse consequence only for the reason for having reported such incidents.

Punishment(s) in the event of Ragging

One or more of the following punishments depending on the nature and the gravity of the guilt may beawarded to those found guilty namely:

- > Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- ➤ Withholding /withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- ➤ Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- > Withholding results.
- ➤ Debarring from representing the University/Institution in any regional, national or internationalmeet, tournament, youth festival etc.
- > Suspension/Expulsion from the hostel.
- > Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the University/Institution for period ragging from one to four semesters.
- > Expulsion from the University/Institution and consequent debarring from admission to anyother institution for a specified period.

Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the University shall resort to collective punishment.

In UGC Regulations on Curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 (herein-after referred to as the Principal regulations), in Para 3 the following shall be added after 3(i) under heading what constitutes Ragging.—

Any act of physical or mental abuse (including bullying and exclusion) targeted at another student (fresher or otherwise) on the ground of colour, race, religion, caste, ethnicity, gender (including transgender), sexual orientation, appearance, nationality, regional origins, linguistic identity, place of birth, place of residence or economic background.
