ORDINANCE FOR
THE AWARD OF DOCTOR OF
PHILOSOPHY (Ph.D.)/MASTER OF PHILOSOPHY (M. Phil.) DEGREE PROGRAMME

[Central University Act 2009 — Section 28 (1)(o)]

The degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph. D.) and Master of Philosophy (M. Phil) may be awarded in any subject belonging to concerned School of Studies in the University. Academic matters related to the award of M. Phil./Ph. D. degree shall be supervised by School Board as prescribed in the relevant Ordinance.

The general terms and conditions for admission, registration, evaluation and award of M. Phil./Ph. D. degree will be in accordance with the provisions of UGC regulations (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M. Phil./Ph. D. Degree) 2016 or the UGC regulation as amended from time to time.

The eligibility criteria for admission to the M. Phil/Ph. D. Program shall be as prescribed in the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulation as amended from time to time.

The duration of M. Phil./Ph. D. Program shall be as prescribed in the UGC regulations (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M. Phil./Ph. D. Degree) 2016 or the UGC regulation as amended from time to time.

The extension beyond the limits so prescribed shall be governed by the relevant clause as stipulated the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulations.

The admission procedure for M. Phil./Ph. D. program shall be as prescribed in the UGC regulations (Minimum standards and procedure for award of M. Phil./Ph. D. Degree) 2016 or the UGC regulation as amended from time to time.

The implementation of the procedure and the process of selection for admission to M. Phil. Ph. D. program shall be as prescribed in the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulations.

The allocation of the research supervisor and the eligibility for recognizing a research supervisor shall be as prescribed by the UGC regulations and as detailed out in the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulations.

The course work prescribed for the M. Phil./ Ph. D. program shall be framed as per the guidelines prescribed and conduct of course work and its evaluation shall as prescribed in the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulations.

Registration of students for M. Phil./Ph.D. program shall be as prescribed in the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulations.

Selection of topic, preparation of synopsis and evaluation of the progress report shall be monitored by a Research Advisory Committee (RAC) whose constitutions and functions shall as be as prescribed in the M. Phil./ Ph. D. regulations.

The topic of research and synopsis approval as well as six monthly progress reports after the RAC recommendation shall be submitted to DRC and after its recommendation it shall be submitted to School Board for approval.

The allocation of Co-supervisor/Care-taker supervisor and transfer of Ph. D. Data in case of women candidate (if need be) shall be in accordance with the UGC regulations after the approval of School Board on the recommendation of RAC.

The assessment, submission, evaluation and the award of M. Phil./Ph. D. degree shall be as prescribed in the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulations.

The minimum residency period for M. Phil./Ph. D. program shall be as prescribed in the M. Phil./Ph.D. regulation.

The constitution, function and powers of Departmental Research Committee shall be as prescribed in the M. Phil./Ph. D. Regulations.
