

About the University & the Department:

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, started its journey as a state university since 1985, is now a central university in Chhattisgarh established under the Central Universities Act, 2009. So, it is highly required that alternatives strategies to be developed to support students language learning for developing language skills and for reading for pleasure. Reading cards can be cost-effective but productive strategy to ensure this purpose. Hence, the department proposes an activity for developing effective reading cards for upper primary level students by experts, school teachers, teacher educators and ELT trained teachers/subject experts.

Under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMNMTT) Scheme of MHRD, the department envisioned development and distribution of reading cards in English for upper primary level to extend its support for the enrichment of the school children of the state. The whole project will be covered throughout the year and the third workshop is being organized at this third phase on the proposed dates for developing reading materials on different themes.

Conception of Reading Cards

The set of conceived reading cards is not only an imaginative but exciting. A reading card is far cheaper than a book but still has a book-like feel in terms of shape, size, colour and matter. The enjoyable stories and colourful illustrations presented in a durable, laminated format are bound to mesmerize the young learners and improve their reading skills.

The cards are specifically designed for independent self-paced reading. Each reading card contains a complete self-contained text. The texts are wide-ranging with passages on people, place, science, folktales, and stories from real life and mythology with lively and imaginative illustrations to accompany them. At the end of the text simple comprehension, grammar and vocabulary exercises enable self-evaluation.
