Report on Cyber Jagrookta Diwas On Completion of One Year - 06.10.2022

Cyber Jagrookta Diwas (CJD), an awareness programme on cyber and digital security successfully completed its one year as per the guidelines issued by ministry and statutory bodies from time to time. In reference to it, a meeting, of all the members of the committee constituted to observe CJD at GGV campus, Coordinator of IT Cell Dr Arun Sharma, members of IT Cell faculty members and PhD scholars was conducted on 6.10.2022 at 11AM in the CSIT Department to celebrate the completion of first year of CJD. Different issues related to cyber security were discussed over there. After an in-depth discussion and considering all aspects, the faculty and audience present in the hall proposed following action plan for the forth coming year

- i. Every first Wednesday of every month, school level talk or lecture or series of program shall be organized.
- ii. Mass level awareness drive should be conducted through all official social media handles of the University. Ministry of Education (MoE), department of higher education, government India has issued cyber safety tips through social media handles of 14c via linked-In, Instagram, Facebook, twitter for detailed cyber safety tips.
- iii. Cyber security and hygiene awareness banner must be put up in campus in different places like hostels and cafeteria.
- iv. Use of firewall should be made regularly to prohibit/ block cyber frauds and suspicious websites. Ranmsomware must be prohibited and access to all fraudulent sites must be stopped.
- v. The students already enrolled and newly admitted students shall be introduced cyber security aspects in their orientation program.
- vi. Community awareness program on cyber security and hygiene shall be conducted in collaboration with NSS.
- vii. Radio broadcasting channels and media cell will function as the sharing platform of cyber awareness to protect common people from cyber frauds.
- viii. Purchase of licensed software for GGV students and employees shall be increased to discourage the use of pirated software and consequently prevent fraudulent activities.
- ix. The Committee constituted to observe CJD can be invited to give orientation towards the protection measures of cyber crimes in various Schools/ Departments/ Offices.
- x. Awareness program on fishing websites will be conducted in University at department level and in schools at community level.
- xi. The number of increase in the followings of twitter by ministry on awareness campaign will enhance the understanding of different types of online fraud to be stopped. Maximum use of open source applications must be encouraged.
