

## Guidelines for the Best Research Paper Award to the Faculty of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya

The objective is to provide recognition to the faculty of Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya (GGV) and thereby motivate them to engage in quality and excellence in research.

The award consists of a cash prize of Rs. 5,000/- and a Certificate of Appreciation.

The award will be given for a Research paper/Review article published in a journal in the Calendar year preceeding the year of award.

### Criteria for award for faculty members on research papers

1. Each year Two Best Papers will be selected from the whole university and distributed one each from the following two groups of Schools of Studies (Group A and Group B), as per the conditions mentioned in the table:

2. Only the full time faculty members of the University shall be eligible to receive the award.
3. The paper published by faculty must have affiliation of GGV, Bilaspur.
4. The article submitted for the award must have been published during the preceding calendar year and uploaded by the faculty on the "Samarth portal".
5. All the GGV affiliated authors mentioned in the publication will be eligible for receiving/sharing the award.
6. For multiple author publication, the amount of award shall be distributed equally among the authors from GGV and each of the co-author will be provided with a separate certificate of appreciation.
7. ONLY ONE PUBLISHED PAPER (copy duly signed by the author/s) shall be submitted for consideration of the award.
