Frequently Asked Questions Regarding Participation in AIU Central Zone Students Research Convention: ANVESHAN (2016-17)

When and where the ANVESHAN (2016-17) will be held?

Association of Indian Universities (AIU) Central Zone Students Research Convention: ANVESHAN (2016-17) to be held at Dr. C.V. Raman University, Bilaspur during 28th Feb. 2017 to 1st March 2017.

Who can participate in the ANVESHAN (2016-17)?

Entries of the Research Projects are purely Institutional and only Bonafide Fulltime Students from Undergraduate to Doctoral Degree level, who are below 30 years of age, are eligible to take part in the Convention

What are the Objectives of the ANVESHAN (2016-17)?

- 1. To identify young talents with research aptitude and interest to take up research as career option.
- 2. To promote the talent in research throughout the country.
- 3. To nurture the talent through specialized training and education in some of the nationally and internationally reputed premier institutions of higher learning in the country.
- 4. To augment financial and physical resources through collaboration with different sponsors for supporting education and training of the young researchers.
- 5. To provide proper incentives to enhance the research skill of potential students.
- 6. To initiate an intensive research culture in the universities and institutions.

What are Categories/Areas/Fields for the ANVESHAN (2016-17)?

The areas/fields in which Projects (Individual and Group Projects*) are invited:

- 1. Agriculture
- 2. Basic Sciences

- 3. Engineering & Technology
- 4. Health Sciences and Allied Subjects, Pharmacy, Nutrition, etc.
- 5. Social Sciences, Humanities, Commerce and Law (Objective and Result Oriented Projects)
- * In case of a Group project, only three members (one principal investigator and two major contributors) are allowed to participate in the Zonal/ National Convention.

What should be the Nature of the Project to be submitted for ANVESHAN (2016-17)?

Projects on the above mentioned areas must be original and must have undergone some exploration/ground work in order to show its feasibility and impact.

What is the Programme Structure of ANVESHAN (2016-17)?

The Convention shall be held in three phases.

- i. In the First Phase, all universities in the country are requested to organize an exhibition of research projects at University Level in which students from Affiliated/Constituent Colleges, Research Institutions and University Teaching Departments are invited to participate and contest. The exhibited projects are scrutinized by a team of experts of their respective areas and the best five projects are selected for participation in the second phase.
- ii. In the Second Phase, the Convention is held at Zonal Levels in five Zones viz. East, West, North, South and Central where the winners of first phase participate. The zonal distribution of universities is displayed on AIU Website www.aiuweb.org. In each Zone, one university is indentified on the basis of certain criteria and the responsibility to conduct the Convention is assigned to it. From each zone, 15 best projects, three in each category are scrutinized on the basis of laid down assessment criteria for giving entry to compete at the National Level.
- iii. In the Third Phase, the Convention is held at National Level. The Association of Indian Universities invites the successful projects, selected through the zonal competition, for the national level competition. A total of 75 selected projects are displayed for assessment at the national level out of which 15 projects are finally selected for awards.
- iv. The duration of the Convention is three days each at Zonal and National Level.

How to participate in First Phase in Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya?

- In the *First Phase*, the Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya will organize an exhibition of research projects at University level.
- The exhibition of research projects at University level for the students of the University (GGV) shall be held on 15/02/2017 from 2.0 PM at University Auditorium (Rajat Jayanti Sabhagar).
- As per eligibility, any bonafide student of the GGV can submit their project proposal in the prescribed format duly forwarded by their respective head of department on or before 13/01/2017 to the following faculty members in soft copy. The hard copy of the same should be submitted to **Office of the Director, Institute of Technology, GGV.**

• If selected in the first round, the projects will be allowed for the second round at Central Zone Students Research Convention: ANVESHAN (2016-17) to be held at Dr. C.V. Raman University, Bilaspur during 28th Feb. 2017 to 1st March 2017.
