ORDER

The institutions mentioned in the table under para 3 below had submitted applications to the Western Regional Committee of National Council for Teacher Education for grant of recognition to B.Ed in terms of Section 14(1) and 15(1) of NCTE Act, 1993, among others.

2. The WRC at its 92nd (Extended) meeting held from 22nd December, 2006 at Bhopal considered applications of the institutions included in the Agenda for the meeting and after careful examination of relevant documents, Visiting Team Reports, Video Recording etc. and the institutions compliance reports on deficiencies found the institutions mentioned in para 3 below fit for grant of recognition of the courses and intake mentioned against their names.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 14(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to these institutions for the course and intake mentioned against their names as under.

4. The institutions shall ensure the fulfillment of the following :-

- The institutions shall maintain the teaching staff strength of 1+7 for the sanctioned B.Ed. and all the appointments would be on regular basis on an approved scale of payment of the candidates having fulfilled eligibility condition prescribed by NCTE. The institute concerned shall send a report in this regard to WRC of NCTE within 30 days, in terms of clause 7 (12) of the NCTE Regulations 2005.
- The institutions shall note that with regard to NET / SLET requirement, the relaxation is allowed only upto the year 2009-2010 as per NCTE Regulation dt. 21.7.2006.
- The institutions shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.
- The institutions shall within one month of the receipt of the Recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 50 months (Five Years) in a Nationalized Bank only to be operated along with an authorized official of the Regional Committee.
- That the Reserve fund for an amount of Rs. Three Lakhs be maintained in the form of FDR in favour of the managements / institutions.



- (f) Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC and State Government etc.
- (g) The institutions shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating University / State Directorate of Education about the appointment of faculty members and the Statement of Annual Accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- (h) The institutions shall regularly update their website.
- (i) The institutions intending to run the teachers training programme approved above in a rented premises are required to submit report in compliance of the requirement of NCTE Regulations on the subject.

5. If any of the institutions contravene any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and order made or issued there under, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993. The NCTE may also cause inspections under Section 13 of NCTE Act, 1993.

6. It is mandatory for the institutions to complete 180 teaching days as such the concerned university board should ensure the recognition granted as per NCTE regulations and if the recognition date did not match with the academic calendar then the recognition granted shall be effective from the ensuing academic session.



10. The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always following as mandatory disclosure:

- (i) Copy of the Application Form
- (ii) Land and Building Particulars.
- (iii) Staff Profile.
- (iv) Recognition letter.
- (v) Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

11. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

12. Further, if the institution is not satisfied by the order, they can prefer an appeal to National Council for Teacher Education, Hans Bhawan, Wing-II, 1, Bahadur Shah Zafar Marg, Near ITO, New Delhi- 110002 against this order under section 18 of the NCTE Act, 1993 within 60 days of the issue of this order. The guidelines of appeal are enclosed herewith.

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Recognition Order

WHEREAS in terms of Section 14(1)/Section 15(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, GURU GHASIDAS UNIVERSITY, KONI, BILASPUR 495009 CHATTISGARH has submitted an application (Code No.- APW07580/725029) to the Western Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition/permission for conducting M.ED.(H & E)(CO.ED) course with an annual intake of 25 students on 9-01-2008 .

2. AND WHEREAS on scrutiny/perusal of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith , the affidavit and the input received from the visiting team in the form of report and videography, recommendation of the State Government, the Committee is satisfied that the institution/society fulfills the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the PG teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, library, accommodation, financial resources, laboratory etc. for running the programme and has selected/appointed duly qualified teaching staff as per NCTE norms.
3. NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) /15(3)(a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Western Regional Committee hereby grants recognition / permission to DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, GURU GHASIDAS UNIVERSITY, KONI, BILASPUR 495009 CHATTISGARH for conducting M.ED.(H & E)(CO.ED) from academic session 2009-2010 course of PG of 1 year duration with an annual intake of 25 (PG) under clause 7(11) of NCTE(Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulation 2007.
4. The institution shall, within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the endowment fund and reserve fund account into a joint account to be operated along with an officer of the Western Regional Committee.
5. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
6. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2007.
7. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff for conducting the course is always in position.
8. Further, subject to the provision of NCTE Act 1993, The institution shall fulfill all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC , affiliating University/Body , the State Government etc, applicable.
9. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
