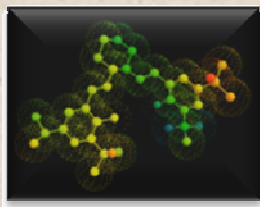

Call for Papers

Faculty and research scholars are invited to present their work on the mentioned topics. The interested participants are requested to submit their abstracts (MS word, Times New Roman, font size 12, 1.0 line spacing, justified, up to 200 words) including title (14, bold, centered), name of author (s), author's affiliation (s) (12, centered) and email id (10, centered). The name of the presenting author must be underlined and mode of presentation (oral/poster) must be mentioned. One author should not submit more than two abstracts.

The Conference Registration Fees

How to reach Bilaspur

By Train: Bilaspur is well connected by Railways /Road transport, and situated on the Mumbai-Nagpur-Howrah route of the Indian Railways.

By Flight: Nearest airport is at Maana, Raipur which is about 126 Km away from Bilaspur City.

How to reach Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya from Bilaspur city:

The University is located at "Koni" which is approximately 10 km from the railway station. Prepaid Autos are available at railway station with fare around Rs. 100. Bilaspur City buses are also regularly plying from Railway station to "Koni" and also inside the University premises.

About the City
