The candidates invited for counselling will be allotted seats based on their merit in VET-2014 and after verification of their minimum eligibility. Relaxation in upper age-limit/ reservation of seats will be as per GOI/UGC/Vishwavidyalaya rules.

1. Two Sets of Photocopy of 10<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and B. Sc. Honours mark sheets along with original
  2. Original Transfer Certificate
  3. Original Migration Certificate
  4. Original Caste Certificate in case of OBC/SC/ST candidates along with two photocopies. Those belonging to reserved category must bring valid **caste certificate** as per government of India **rules**. OBC candidates must bring a **non-creamy-layer** valid certificate from the competent authority as per government of India rules.
  5. Income Certificate for OBC candidates is must
  6. Mark sheet of qualifying examination
  7. Three recent passport size photographs
  8. Gap Certificate, if required
  9. Requisite fees which will be deposited through bank challan issued by the Dept.
  10. Admission fee: Rs. **3900/-** approximately for M.Sc. course in Chemistry
