Spot Admission against vacant seats in B.Tech. I year, 2018-19

The School of Studies of Engineering & Technology, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (CG) is going to conduct **Spot/local/University level Admission** against vacant/drop out seats in B. Tech.- I Year for session 2018-19 in seven branches of Engineering i.e. Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics and Communication Engineering, Information Technology, Industrial & Production Engineering and Mechanical Engineering. The actual vacant seats category-wise available will be notified and displayed on the website (www.ggu.ac.in) on 04/08/2018. Any updates regarding the admission in B. Tech. (2018-19) program based on spot/local admission/Counseling shall be uploaded on the university website only. Candidates are advised to check the university website regularly for updates. Any ignorance will not be an excuse.

1. Eligibility of candidates for Spot/local counseling 2018-19 at Institute level

The JoSAA business rules for the academic year 2018-19 as available in the JoSAA/CSAB 2018 website (as and where applicable) will be followed for the spot counseling at university level to be conducted for admission in B. Tech. I year of the seven branches of Engineering in School of Studies of Engineering & Technology except the eligibility of the candidates to participate in seat allotment process mentioned in section III, page 3 and also stated in Annexure

2(b) of JoSAA business rules. **The eligibility of the candidates to participate in the spot counseling is as follows:**

- i. Secured a rank in JEE (Mains) 2018 paper - 1 and must have passed class 12th or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with one of the Chemistry/Bio-Technology/Technical vocational subject. Further the candidate should have passed in each subject individually as well.
- ii. The candidate should have secured minimum 50% (for GEN or OBC-NCL) or minimum 45% (for SC, ST or PWD) of aggregate marks in class XII (or equivalent examination) of respective stream and board.
- iii. For calculation of the total marks for five subjects, if the marks awarded in a subject is NOT out of 100, then the marks will be scaled (up or down) to 100 so that the total aggregate marks is out of 500.
- iv. If a Board awards only letter grades without providing an equivalent percentage of marks on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the Board specifying the equivalent and submit it at the time of acceptance of the allocated seat. In case such a certificate is not provided, the decision taken by institute admission committee will be final.
- v. If a Board gives aggregate marks considering both Class XI and Class XII examinations (in the 10+2 system), then only Class XII marks will be considered. Similarly, for Boards which follow a

semester system, the marks scored in the final two semesters will be considered.

2. Registration and Admission for Spot Counseling

i) Registration and Admission fee:

Candidates who want to participate in the spot/local/university level counseling shall submit his/her application form online by visiting university website www.ggu.ac.in and by clicking on link **“B.Tech. Admission Spot Counseling 2018”** on or before **August 09, 2018**.

While visiting the above link, click Candidate Login/New Registration, fill up the information required and choose options for payment mode online. The registration fee for taking part in Spot/local/university level counseling is Rs. 500/- (for Open and OBC-NCL) and Rs. 250/- (for SC/ST/PWD) candidates. Without submitting the registration fee, the Registration Form of the candidate will not be accepted. After making payment and final submission, candidate may take a print out of application form and retain it with himself/herself and bring a copy of the downloaded (printed) application form at the time of document verification. Please do not send print out of filled in online application form to the institute/Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya.

ii) Date of Online Registration:

Opening of Online registration process on 04th August, 2018.

&

Closing of Online registration process on 9th August, 2018.

- iii) Declaration of Merit List of registered candidates on **10 August 2018, after 5:00 PM** on University website www.ggu.ac.in.
- iv) Verification of documents on **13 August 2018 from 9:30 AM - 12.00 Noon.**
- v) Allotment of seat **13 August 2018 2.00 PM onwards.**
- vi) **Venue of Spot Admission:**
E-Class Room, School of Engineering & Technology (Institute of Technology)
Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.)
- vii) Physical presence of candidate is compulsory.

3. Documents Required at the Time of Admission

- a) Copy of online filled in application/registration form (submitted through university website www.ggu.ac.in)
- b) Fee amounting **Rs. 29,350/-** to be paid through Net banking/Credit/Debit card online.
- c) Original JEE (MAINS) 2018 **ADMIT CARD**, JEE (MAINS) 2018 **SCORE CARD**.
- d) Original **Class X** (High School) Board Certificate as a proof of date of birth.
- e) Original **Class XII** Mark sheet.
- f) **Transfer, Character and Migration Certificate** from the last school/college (All in original).

- g) Certificate of Category (OBC/SC/ST), if applicable, issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by JOSAA-2018 (Central Government Formats).
- h) Latest Income certificate for OBC-NCL candidate (issued on or after 01/04/2018).
- i) Certificate for Person with Disabilities (PWD), if applicable.
- j) One set of self attested copy of all the above certificates.
- k) Medical certificate from a duly competent authority.
- l) Gap certificate, if applicable (Original).
- m) Six passport sized photo.

4. Procedure for Selection

- a) A category wise merit list of registered candidates will be prepared based on JEE (MAINS) 2018 rank of the applicants.
- b) Selection will be subject to document submission and verification.
- c) Allotment of seats will be done on the basis of merit list of registered candidates and vacancy available at that time.
- d) If a candidate, after confirmation of his/her admission, withdraws/cancels his/her admission then admission fee of **Rs. 29,350/-** paid by the candidate will be forfeited by the School/University and no communication in this regard will be entertained.
- e) In case a candidate is found to have furnished false information or document(s) etc. or is found to have withheld or concealed any material

information while submitting their application, their candidature/ result/ admission will be cancelled and fee deposited by him/her shall be forfeited.

- f) All candidates finally admitted through spot round will have to complete the admission formalities on **13 August 2018**.
- g) The decision of Vice-Chancellor, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur (C.G.) in respect of the Spot Admission for B.Tech. First Year for the session 2018-19, shall be final and binding.

5. Hostel Accommodation

- a) Limited Seats are available for boys and girls in their respective hostels.
- b) Hostel fee for New Boys hostel is Rs. 10000/- (room rent) + Rs. 2000/- (caution money) + Rs. 4000/- (Mess caution money) + Rs. 2690/- (one month mess advance). Total Boys Hostel fee to be paid at the time of admission Rs. 18690/-. Hostel fee for Girls hostel is Rs. 6750/- + Rs. 2000/- (caution money) + Rs. 4000/- (Mess caution money) + Rs. 2690/- (one month mess advance). Total Girls Hostel fee to be paid at the time of admission Rs. 15440/-.
- c) Formalities for hostel will be processed only after the issue of admission letter by the school. Any prior communication in this regard will not be entertained.

6. General Instructions

- a) No TA/DA is admissible for appearing in the Counseling.

- b) Candidates are required to submit only one application form. If a candidate submits more than one application form, his/ her candidature is liable to be cancelled.
- c) For all legal matters, the jurisdiction will be the Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh only.
