### Admission to Ph.D Programme

Through Vishwavidyalaya Research Entrance Test (VRET)

&

VRET- Exempted Category

Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya invites applications for admission to programmes leading to Doctor of Philosophy Degree (herein after referred to as the Ph. D. Degree) in various disciplines as given in Section - A, Table-1. Admissions shall be done as per University Ph.D. Regulations 2018 and as decided by the Academic Council of the University from time to time in accordance with the UGC minimum qualification for M.Phil. / Ph.D. Regulations. The admission to the said programme shall be made (a) through the Vishwavidyalaya Research Entrance Test (VRET) to be conducted at Bilaspur (University Campus) on 08.02.2020 (Saturday) and (b) directly under the VRET exempted category.

**Note:- Admission to PhD program shall be subjected to the availability of seats and supervisor. The University reserves the right to fill or not to fill any seat and also to alter the nature and number of seats if the circumstances so warrant. (List of Supervisors, their specialization and number of seats available is attached herewith as Annexure-1)**

#### **B. ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY**

##### **(i) For VRET Category-**

1. Applicant for admission to the Ph.D. program shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.

*Provided* further that, the students appearing for final year or final semester of their post-graduate degree examination will also be eligible to appear for the admission process subject to the fulfillment of minimum eligibility criteria at the time of interview/counseling.

2. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-abled and other categories of applicant as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories

mentioned above are permissible based on only the qualifying marks. Mathematical rule of rounding off numbers shall not be followed for calculation of percentage of marks.

3. Applicant possessing a Degree, considered equivalent to M.Phil. Degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, subject to the approval of Equivalence Committee of this University, shall also be eligible for admission to Ph.D. program.

(ii) For VRET Exempted (in addition to B (i))-

1. Permanent/Regular teachers having appointment on substantive posts in the Teaching departments of the Universities who have completed their probation successfully with an experience of at least two years of uninterrupted service would be considered under this category.
2. Foreign students sponsored by the concerned embassy and having appropriate fellowship will be exempted from test, subject to the general rules framed by the Government of India from time to time and as applicable to the University with regard to the admission etc.
3. **Applicants** who have qualified UGC-NET (including JRF)/UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/SLET(having own fellowship)/GATE/teacher fellowship holder /GPAT/JEST/RGNF/DST Inspire or any such applicants who belong to this category as per UGC notifications from time to time.
4. Applicants who have successfully completed M.Phil. from GGV or any recognized institutions.

Note:- **Applicants must satisfy himself/herself about fulfilling the minimum eligibility requirements as prescribed above before filling the online Application Form.**

### **C. PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION**

(I) There would be two streams of applicants, namely

1. Applying against available seats in a subject which shall be filled by **Vishwavidyalaya Research Entrance Test (VRET)**

University will admit applicants by a two stage process i.e. Entrance test followed by an interview:

- a) The qualifying marks in the Entrance Test shall be 50% of the total marks. However, a relaxation of 5 % of marks (from 50% to 45%) shall be allowed for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy layers) / Differently-abled category in the entrance examination conducted by the University as per UGC Regulations.

The syllabus of the Entrance Test shall consist of 50% of research methodology and 50% shall be subject specific. **The VRET would be of 120 minutes duration.** There would be a single question paper of 100 marks having 100 multiple choice questions for assessing the subject proficiency and research aptitude of the candidate. The admission shall be based on the marks obtained above qualifying marks in VRET and in order of merit. Entrance Tests Syllabus of different subjects is attached herewith as **Annexure-2**.

**b) Distribution of marks will be as follows-**

- i. Marks obtained in VRET – weightage 70% of the marks obtained (Maximum 70)
- ii. Personal Interview/Viva-voce/Presentation- 30

Total= 100

2. Applying against available seats in a subject which shall be filled by candidates not appeared in VRET i.e. called **VRET-Exempted category**

**VRET Exempted (For UGC-NET (including JRF)/UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/SLET/GATE/Teacher Fellowship holder/GPAT/JEST/RGNF/DST-Inspire or any other category as notified by the UGC from time to time)**

- a. Personal Interview/Viva-voce- 20
- b. Research proposal presentation- 30
- c. Score of UGC-NET (including JRF)/UGC-CSIR NET (including JRF)/SLET/GATE (excluding Teacher Fellowship holders) – Weightage 50% of the normalized score (Maximum 50 marks )
- d. For Teacher Fellowship Holders those not having any score and only awarded with fellowship the 50% marks will be given as follows-

Academic background

For 10th (HSC)- 5 (5 For more than 75%, 3 for 75%to 60%, 2 for less than 60%)

For 12th (HSSC)—5 (5 For more than 75%, 3 for 75%to 60%, 2 for less than 60%)

For Under Graduate- 20(20 For more than 75%, 15 for 75%to 60%, 10 for less than 60%)

For Post Graduate- 20(20 For more than 75%, 15 for 75%to 60%, 10 for less than 60%)

**(II) Final Merit list of the applicants belonging to both the categories i.e. VRET and VRET (Exempted) will be prepared separately for each subject. The overall marks for preparing such merit will be 100.**

### **(III) SHORTLISTING**

(a) The short listing of applications for VRET and VRET Exempted applicants for the concerned subjects for the purpose of admission test/interview will be done separately by the Admission Committee constituted for the purpose of concerned department/ Research Centre.

(b) The committee of the concerned department then shortlist the applications as per the short-listing criteria as described in Regulations and Admission Brochure for preparing merit list. University may notify, if considered necessary, modification in the short listing criteria higher than those defined above.

**(IV)** The DRC would prepare category wise VRET and VRET exempted merit lists. The final selection list will be displayed on the University's website as well as on the departmental Notice Board.

### **D. Details of Course Work**

1. All provisionally admitted students shall undertake a course work for a minimum period of one semester (Six Months) or as prescribed by the UGC/University from time to time.
2. A temporary mentor would be allotted to the students by the DRC to be approved by School Board before the start of the course work. As far as possible, the mentor would be the supervisor to whom student would be allotted after the successful completion of the course work.
3. **The responsibility of the Mentor will be to monitor the progress of the students, guide the student for preparing seminars/assignments/presentations, if any and also motivate for literature search and library skills.**
4. All applicants admitted to the Ph.D. program shall be required to complete the Ph.D. course work successfully prescribed by the Department during the initial 1 or 2 Semesters. If the student is unable to qualify Pre Ph.D. Course Work successfully after second attempt, his/her admission will be cancelled automatically.
5. Ph.D. scholar has to obtain a minimum of 55% of marks or its equivalent in the course work in order to be eligible to continue in the program leading to the completion of Ph.D. thesis. A Mark-sheet/ Grade-Card would be issued by the University.
6. If a student fails to qualify the course work examination in first attempt, he/ she will be given only one additional attempt to clear the course work examination to qualify after paying due fees. However, in all such cases where the student fails to pass the Course-work examination in first attempt, he/ she would not be given the benefit of the duration of repeating the course work for the minimum residency period in continuity. In all such cases, the residency period of only one semester (6 months) shall be reckoned for successful completion of the course-work.



7. Successful completion of Course Work would be binding on all the Ph.D. students including VRET-Exempted Category applicants.

**E. RESERVATION:**

**Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/EWS and PWD applicants will be provided as per Government of India rules.**

Each SC/ST/OBC/EWS applicant shall have to submit a copy of the certificate mentioning that the applicant belongs to SC/ST/OBC/EWS community. Such certificates shall be subject to verification from the concerned District Magistrate. The following are empowered to issue the certificate:

- (a) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/ Addl. Deputy Commissioner/Deputy Collector/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/City Magistrate/ Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- (b) Chief Presidency Magistrate/Addl. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Presidency Magistrate.
- (c) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- (d) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the applicant and/or his family normally resides.
- (e) Administrator/Secretary to the Administrator/ Development Officer (Lakshadweep Islands).

**Applicants must note that the certificate from any other person/authority shall not be accepted in any case.**

**F. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- (i) An applicant who satisfies the requirements mentioned in **Section B** should apply on the prescribed Application Form for **VRET/VRET (Exempted)**. The application shall be submitted online only.
- (ii) Application Forms of applicants who have submitted forged/fake information or adopted fraudulent means shall be REJECTED without any intimation to the applicants. Further, such applicants shall be debarred from appearing in any subsequent Entrance Tests conducted by GGVS.
- (iii) Applicants are allowed to appear at the VRET provisionally subject to the final verification of Mark sheets/Degrees/certificates, validity of certificates/Mark sheets of Qualifying Examination and also of involvement in the adoption of unfair means in any of the University Examination/Entrance Tests held earlier, at the time of admission. Degrees/certificates recognized by Association of Indian

Universities (AIU) shall only be deemed as equivalent degrees/certificates.

The Distance Education Council of India/Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU)/Association of Indian Universities (AIU) are the only authority to recognize the Degrees/certificates of Distance Education. Such Applicants are provisionally permitted to appear in the VRET and will be required to submit certificates from Distance Education Council of IGNOU, New Delhi regarding recognition/approval of the courses.

- (iv) Mere appearance in the Entrance Test or securing a place in merit at the written Test does not entitle an applicant to be considered for admission to a discipline unless he/she fulfils the eligibility conditions. APPLICANTS MUST FULLY SATISFY THEMSELVES ABOUT THEIR ELIGIBILITY AS PRESCRIBED ABOVE, BEFORE FILLING THE APPLICATION FORM.

If an applicant is inadvertently allowed to appear at the Entrance Test who otherwise does not fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements, he/she cannot, at a later date, use that as a right to claim that he/she meets the eligibility requirements.

The University reserves the right to cancel/refuse admission at any point of time if it is found that:

- (a) Minimum eligibility requirements are not fulfilled.
  - (b) False documentation has been done.
  - (c) Any other similar valid reason.
- (v) Applicants appearing at the VRET shall be subject to Rules, Regulations and Ordinances relating to the University examinations. Applicants found adopting unfair means shall be liable to punishment as per University rules.
- (vi) (a) In case of any dispute relating to the VRET/admission to Ph.D., the decision of the University shall be final. An appeal may lie to the Vice-Chancellor, GGV against such decision. In no case any applicant shall take recourse to the court of law directly.
- (b) In case of any litigation relating to the VRET/admission to Ph.D. course, the District Court of Bilaspur and the High Court of Judicature of Bilaspur shall only have the jurisdiction.
- (vii) No TA/DA will be paid to applicants for appearing in Entrance Test/Interview.

#### **G. APPLICATION PROCESSING FEE:**

A applicant desirous of appearing in VRET or VRET (Exempted Category) shall pay the Fee of Rs.1000/- in case of General/OBC/EWS and Rs.500/- in case of SC/ST/PWD Category **and shall be paid through online mode only during the process of registration.**

#### **I. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORM:**

Applicant for VRET/VRET-Exempted category shall submit the application through online mode only. There is no need to submit the hardcopy of application form submitted online for VRET. Candidates have to retain the printout of online submitted application form with them and they have to produce it before the Admission Committee/DRC while asked to do so, accompanied with all relevant documents in support of education qualification, age, category etc.

**Applicants applying under VRET-Exempted category have to send printout of online submitted application form with all relevant documents in support of education qualification, age, category etc. to Assistant Registrar, Academic, Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Koni, Bilaspur (CG)-495009, on or before 30.01.2020, 05.00 PM through speed post/registered post/courier/by hand.**

**The University will not be responsible for any postal delay.**

#### **J. DOWNLOADING OF ADMIT CARD: (For applicants appearing in VRET)**

**PROVISIONAL ADMIT CARD** indicating the venue of the test for appearing the examination can be **downloaded by the applicant from the university web site [www.ggu.ac.in](http://www.ggu.ac.in).**

#### **K. TEST CENTRE:**

The Vishwavidyalaya Research Entrance Test (VRET) shall be conducted at Guru Ghasidas Vishwavidyalaya, Bilaspur only, on **08.02.2020** (Saturday), 10.00 AM

#### **L. METHOD OF ANSWERING THE TEST:**

- (i) A Question Booklet containing the questions and a separate Answer Sheet (**OMR**) shall be provided to the applicant at the beginning of the Test.
- (ii) The applicant, within 10 minutes of the issue of the Questions Booklet, shall check the Question Booklet to ensure that it contains all the pages in correct sequence and that no page/question is

missing. In case of faulty Question Booklet, the applicant shall immediately bring it to the notice of the Superintendent / Invigilators to obtain a fresh Question Booklet.

- (iii) The applicant is required to write his/her *Roll Number, Question Booklet No. and Set No.*, if any, at the appropriate places provided in the answer sheet in INK/Ball Point pen only. In addition, he/she is also required to fill up Roll Number in the space provided at the bottom of the answer sheet by darkening the appropriate circles by Blue/Black Ball Point pen only.
- (iv) The applicant is required to write in BLUE/BLACK Ball Point pen only, his/her Roll number and Serial Number of Answer Sheet at the appropriate places on the cover page of the Question Booklet.
- (v) Each question shall be followed by four alternative answers. The applicant is required to identify the one which he/she feels to be the correct answer and record the answer by darkening the appropriate circle in the answer sheet with Blue/Black Ball Point pen only, as will also be mentioned in the guidelines given on the first page of the Answer Sheet. For example, if out of 4 alternatives (1) (2) (3) & (4) given against question No. 15 the applicant identifies (2) as the correct answer, then he/she is required to darken the *circle No. 2 only* in the Answer Sheet as given below:

**Q. No. 15**



- (vi) The answer will be treated incorrect if more than one circle is darkened or a circle is darkened improperly for any question. Any other method of marking such as tick mark, cross mark, use of dot, line mark and half-filled circle or marks outside the circle shall not be evaluated. There is no negative marking.
- (vii) If any question is not attempted, the applicant is required to leave all the circles against that question as blank. Such an answer will be awarded *zero* marks.
- (viii) Inner cover page of the Question Booklet or the blank space/page of the end of Question Booklet may be used for rough work.
- (ix) No page from the Question Booklet is to be torn or removed. If an applicant is found tearing any page from the Question Booklet he/she shall be liable to punishment for adopting unfair means and shall not be allowed to continue in the Entrance Test.

**M. IMPORTANT**

- (i) APPLICANTS TO NOTE THAT, SINCE ANSWERS ARE TO BE MARKED IN INK, IT WILL NOT BE POSSIBLE TO CHANGE ANY ANSWER AFTER MARKING IT.
- (ii) Applicants found using/adopting unfair means in the VRET shall be disqualified from the test and also shall be debarred from admission to any other course even in future. The rules, regulations and ordinances of the University framed from time to time shall be applied for all applicants who participated in the test.
- (iii) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained anywhere in the ordinances of the University, no scrutiny/ revaluation of the answer book of the applicant shall be allowed on any ground. Further, no representation or any enquiry regarding the conduct of the test shall be entertained.

**N. IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS APPEARING IN VRET:**

- (i) The Applicant must carry his/her valid Admit Card for the Test. He/She must occupy only his/her allotted seat as per his/her Roll Number in the seating arrangement made for the Test.
- (ii) No Applicant shall be allowed to the Test Hall after commencement of the Entrance Test.
- (iii) No Applicant shall be allowed to leave the Test Hall till the end of the Test.
- (iv) There is no provision to provide or permit a 'writer' in the Entrance Test except for blind applicants, who will be provided 'writers' on request.
- (v) The Applicants shall be checked for any resource materials frequently and at random by the Invigilators and other staff conducting the Test.
- (vi) Calculators/watch calculators, electronic diary, pager, mobile phones, earphones, alarm clock, digital watches with memory, slide rule, etc. are not allowed in the examination hall. Also, carrying of licensed weapon, fire arms, tools which can be used as lethal weapons are not allowed in the examination hall.
- (vii) The VRET of an applicant shall be cancelled in case of any of the following actions by an applicant: Relevant or irrelevant resource material or loose paper found on his/her possession, or, lying on or around his/her seat, Possession of any unauthorized instrument or equipment as mentioned at (vi) above, Communication of information in writing or verbally or exchange of Question Booklet/Answer Sheets to and from any other person during the Entrance Test period and any other malpractice amounting to obtaining undue advantage, Writing anything on the Admit Card, Carrying of the envelope of the Admit Card and seating plan into the examination hall, Any alterations or

corrections in the entries made by an applicant in Question Booklet and OMR Sheet [Roll Number in words & figures and OMR sheet no. in Question Booklet and Roll Number, Question Booklet no. and Set no. (if any) in OMR sheet] but not duly verified by the invigilator concerned, Non-matching of signature made at the time of VRET with that already done at the time of filling of Application Form.

- (viii) **The VRET/Admission of an applicant shall be cancelled and applicant shall be debarred to appear from future Tests in case of any of the following:**

Tampering with the Admit Card including that of the photograph, face not resembling the photograph on the Admit Card, not occupying the allotted seat, tampering/disturbing the seating arrangements, smuggling-out or smuggling-in Question Booklet in part or in full, or Test material, or any resource material connected with the Test, Making any attempt to influence the University authorities directly or indirectly, Disturbing or trying to disturb the VRET, Noting down the questions or their answers, Shouting of slogans or creating unruly scene at the examination hall/examination center/University campus.

- (ix) **Impersonation is a legally punishable offence.** No Applicant will be permitted to appear in the Test without a valid Admit Card. The Admit Card should be presented to the invigilators/other authorized officials for verification. The applicant's identity will be verified in respect of his/her details on the Admit Card/Registration Form. If the identity is in doubt, the applicant may not be allowed to appear in the Test. The authorities may at their discretion provisionally permit the applicant to appear in the Test after completing formalities including taking of thumb impression/several signatures for further verification. No extra time will be granted for these formalities to be completed.

Similarly, at the time of Personal Interview and admission, the applicant's identity will be verified from the documents produced along with the application form and in case of any doubt, his/her admission will be deferred till final verification.

A person found to impersonate an applicant shall be handed over to the Police under an FIR lodged by the University. The applicant in reference shall be debarred from future Entrance Tests of the University.

A student or employee of the University if found to impersonate during the Test, he/she shall be rusticated or dismissed from the University service.

- (x) **Suppression/concealment of information:** The applicant must ensure that he/she is eligible to

appear in the Test. If it is detected at any stage that he/she did not fulfill the minimum eligibility requirement or there was something against the applicant which would have prevented him/her from being admitted in the concerned discipline, or, the applicant has provided false information or no information about his/her previous involvement in an act punishable under law or act of gross misconduct and indiscipline, then his/her candidature shall not be considered and his/her admission if already made shall be cancelled at any stage and he/she shall be debarred from appearing in any of the future Test of the University.

- (xi) Nobody other than the University authorized personnel is permitted to move around the Test venue. Any unauthorized persons loitering around the Test venue shall be handed over to the police under an FIR lodged by the University.
- (xii) No scrutiny/re-evaluation of answer sheet of the Test is allowed in any case at any stage.
- (xiii) The applicant shall be bound by the GGU Statutes/Ordinances/Rules and Regulations framed from time to time.
- (xiv) **Medium of question papers for Vishwavidyalaya Research Entrance Test (VRET) will be as follows-**

- (xv) Any litigation in respect of the Test shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the local Court of Bilaspur and/or Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Bilaspur only.

**O. FELLOWSHIP:**

All the eligible full-time research scholars of university teaching departments admitted through VRET and not getting any financial assistance from any funding agency will be entitled for fellowship of Rs.8000.00 per month and contingency of Rs.10000.00 per year for science/engineering students and Rs.8000.00 per year for Humanities and Social Science Students as per UGC Norms/ University Ph. D. Ordinance/regulation).

"The fellowship privilege for the scholars involved in acts of indiscipline (on record) may not be extended."

However, fellowship will be subject to approval/sanction of University Grants Commission. Candidates cannot claim the fellowship as their right at any stage.
