- 1. Structure of MSW syllabus semester wise
  - It was approved with minor suggestions i.e. MS: 102; in Semester First Human Growth & Development can be reframed into Human Growth & personality Development with incorporation of contents related to (concepts & meanings of personality, personality traits and deletion of Indian theories of samkhyayoga—in Unit IV). As well as elective paper in third semester related to health was removed for the time being due to paucity of faculty in the department.
- 2. Field work & related regulations
  - Field work attendance should be 100% compulsory and if any student is not able to complete it, than s/he will be supposed to compensate it. On contrary Prof (Dr) Pratibha J. Mishra; Head & Chair, BOS, replied that we will do it gradually, probably in next BOS. Lastly suggestion also given to fix the lower and upper limit of marks in field work, internal exam and block field work should be outside the district in reputed professional organizations. Also incorporate the mid -term introspection in field work.
- 3. Finalization of MSW syllabus

All suggestions given by expert were incorporated immediately in the syllabus. Meeting ended at 8 pm with vote of thanks, the BOS discussed & anonymously approved the structure of syllabus semester wise & fieldwork regulations.
