8. ATTENDANCE AND ELIGIBILITY TO APPEAR IN THE EXAMINATION

A student must have a minimum attendance of 75% of the total number of classes held during the semester including lectures, practicals / tutorials etc., for appearing in the end semester examination. However, Students having attendance more than or equal to 60% and less than 75% shall apply for condonation to the respective Dean of school through the Head of Department. The Dean of School may condone aforesaid shortage in attendance after due consideration of one or more of the following reasons:

- (a) Participation in NCC/NSS Camps, duly supported by a certificate from the Commanding Officer;
- (b) Participation in University Team(s)/Games or Inter-state or Inter-University tournament(s) duly supported by a certificate from appropriate authority of the University;
- (c) Participation in educational excursion conducted on working days certified by the Dean or Head of the department. These excursions shall not include those organized for the class as a whole;
- (d) Participation in any of co-curricular activities organized by the Institute/Department/School, duly certified by competent authority;
- (e) Prolonged illness duly certified by the Registered Medical Practitioner;
- (f) Any other cognet reason up to the satisfaction of the Head of Department/ Dean.

- 7.2.3. Generic Elective (GE) Course: An elective course chosen generally from an unrelated discipline/subject, with an intention to seek exposure is called a Generic Elective.
- P.S.: A core course offered in a discipline/subject may be treated as an elective by other discipline/subject and vice versa and such electives may also be referred to as Generic Elective

7.3. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):

The Ability Enhancement (AE) Courses may be of two kinds: Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC) and Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC). 'AECC' courses are the courses based upon the content that leads to Knowledge enhancement. They (i) Environmental Science and (ii) English/MIL Communicationare mandatory for all disciplines. SEC courses are value-based and/or skill-based and are aimed at providing hands-on-training, competencies, skills, etc.

- 7.3.1. AbilityEnhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC): Environmental Science, English Communication/MIL Communication.
- 7.3.2. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC): These courses may be chosen from a pool of courses designed to provide value-based and/or skill-based knowledge.

Project work / Dissertation is considered as a special course involving application of knowledge in solving / analyzing /exploring a reallife situation / difficult problem. A Project/Dissertation work would be of 6 credits. A Project/Dissertation work may be given in lieu of a discipline specific elective paper.

- 7.4. The Board of Studies of each department will decide the course structure and syllabus for a specific programme.
- 7.5. An undergraduate degree with Honours in a discipline will be awarded with the following course structure as per the UGC guidelines-
 - 24 Core papers in the discipline,
 - 03 Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC),
 - 01 Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC),
 - 01 Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Courses and
 - 02 Generic Elective
