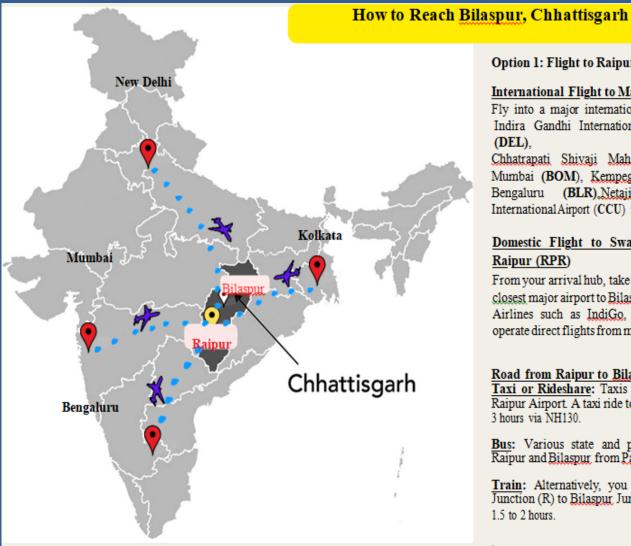

Option 1: Flight to Raipur and Road to Bilaspur

International Flight to Major Hub Airport in India

Fly into a major international hub in India, like Indira Gandhi International Airport in Delhi (DEL).

Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport in Mumbai (BOM), Kempegowda International Airport in Bengaluru (BLR) Netaji Subhas Chandra International Airport (CCU) in Kolkata.

Domestic Flight to Swami Vivekananda Airport in Raipur (RPR)

From your arrival hub, take a domestic flight to Raipur, the closest major airport to Bilaspur.

Airlines such as IndiGo, Air India, and SpiceJet often operate direct flights from major cities to Raipur.

Road from Raipur to Bilaspur (120 km, ~2.5-3 hours) Taxi or Rideshare: Taxis and rideshares are available at Raipur Airport. A taxi ride to Bilaspur will take about 2.5 to 3 hours via NH130.

Bus: Various state and private buses operate between Raipur and Bilaspur from Pandri Bus Stand.

Train: Alternatively, you can take a train from Raipur Junction (R) to Bilaspur Junction (BSP), which takes about 1.5 to 2 hours.

Option 2: Direct Train to Bilaspur

If you're in a major Indian city and want to avoid an extra flight, Bilaspur is well-connected by train from Delhi, Mumbai, Kolkata, and othermajor cities.

Train travel times to Bilaspur are typically:

Delhi: ~20 hours Mumbai: ~24 hours Kolkata: ~12 hours

Local Transport in Bilaspur

Once in Bilaspur, use autorickshaws, app-based rides (like Ola or Uber), or local taxis to reach your destination within the city

Tips for Travelers:

Visa and Documents: Ensure you have the necessary visa and travel documents. Local Language: Hindi is widely spoken; knowing a few basic phrases can be helpful. Currency: The local currency is Indian Rupee (INR); carry some cash for small purchases.
